Silver Jubilee for Eleven Priests

Eleven priests of the Rochester Diocese will mark their silver jubilee of ordination Tuesday, June 6.

They all were ordained by Bishop Kearney at Sacred Heart Cathedral on that date in 1942.

The eleven are the Rev. Fathers Heng F. Adamski, pastor of St. Stanislaus Church, Bradford, and St. Joseph's Church, Campbell; E. Charles Bauer, chaplain at Newark State School; Thomas K. Cleary, pastor of Holy Cross parish, Freeville, and chaplain, George Junior Republic; Joseph M. Egan, pastor, St. Patrick's Church, Elmira; Walter E. Fleming, pastor, St. Salome's Church, Rochester; Clarence W. Gardner, chaplain at Auburn State Prison; Rev. Paul J. Gibbons, chairman of Latin Department at St. Andrew's Seminary; Monsignor Joseph L. Hogan, rector, Becket Hall, Rochester; John D. Hurley, missionary, Mt. Carmel Mission, San Luis, Quorum Province, Philippine Islands; Edward A. Shaanon, pastor, St. Aloysius Church, Auburn, and Richard T. Torney, chaplain at Cornell University, Ithaca.

Father Adamski was born Oct. 4, 1916, the son of Mrs. Walter A. Adamski of Rochester and the late Mr. Adamski. He attended St. Stanislaus school, Rochester, St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries.

He served as an assistant pastor at St. Stanislaus parish, Rochester, 1942 to 1950; at St. John's, Clyde, and St. Patrick's Church, Savannah, 1950 to 1961; and again at St. Stanislaus, Rochester, from 1961 to 1965, at which time he was named to his pastorate at the Bradford and Campbell churches.

He organized and directed the Men's and Women's Holy Name Societies at St. Stanislaus

Church and the Junior Catholic Daughters at the Clyde Savannah parish, in addition to his duties as curate at those churches.

FATHER BAUER will celebrate his jubilee privately. He has issued an appeal, however, to aid him in building a Catholic chapel for the residents of the Newark State School "that the Ministry may be more fruitful in his part of the Vineyard." Contributions may be sent to him at Newark. The proposed Chapel will be built on property adjacent to the School which has an estimated 1000 Catholic residents.

He was active in Sodality, Youth, Vocation and Dramatics programs in his parish assignments and is well-known now as a writer and speaker on the problem of mental retardation.

Father Bauer was born May 7, 1916, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Bauer of Rochester. He attended St. Andrew's school, Rochester, St. Joseph's, Batavia; Aquinas Institute, St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries.

He was active in Sodality, Youth, Vocation and Dramatics programs in his parish assignments and is well-known now as a writer and speaker on the problem of mental retardation.

'Total Africanization' of Churches

Abidjan, Ivory Coast—(RNS)—President Sekou Toure, in a broadcast commemorating the tenth anniversary of the first Guinea government, renewed his demand for the "total Africanization" of Roman Catholic and Protestant Churches in his West African country.

The broadcast, picked up here, commemorated the 20th anniversary of the ruling Guinea Democratic Party. It was made two weeks after the President had declared that any foreign clergy still in Guinea after June 1 would be expelled.

"We demand total Africanization because in 20 centuries, in the history of Christianity, no African or Colored person has been raised to the dignity of archbishop or even bishop in any European country," Mr. Toure said.

"All the countries of Europe, America and Asia have claimed and obtained from the top leadership of Christendom the promotion of their nationals alone to the leading offices in their

Church. So why be surprised, if that Africa, or at least for the moment the Republic of Guinea, should act in the same way?

"We affirm that the African is capable. If this is not so in

the neo-colonized states, it really is so in Guinea's popular regime."
