First Friday Members Slate Rosary Priest

Monsignor Joseph A. Cirincione, pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Church and widely known as director of the nightly WSAY radio broadcast of the Family Rosary for Peace will speak to men of the First Friday Luncheon Club, June 2 at Hotel Sheraton.

The luncheon will begin at 12:10 p.m. Eugene R. Cusker, chairman of the Knights-of-Columbus sponsoring committee said in announcing the speaker.

Father William Donnelly, club moderator and chaplain of Rochester Council K. of C. will present Monsignor Cirincione who recently returned from Fatima where Pope Paul visited to mark the 50th anniversary of the apparitions of the Blessed Mother.

Monsignor Cirincione has led several pilgrimages to the famed shrine. He established a shrine at his church to the Blessed Mother and on March 4, 1950 inaugurated the broadcasts of the Family Rosary over WSAY which has been heard by millions since the first night.

He was born in Rochester and attended St. Andrew's and St. Bernard's Seminaries. Cardinal Mooney, the fourth Bishop of Rochester ordained him, June 9, 1934. He became pastor of St. Francis of Assisi Church July 1, 1934. He was appointed by Pope Paul to Papal Chamberlain with the title of Very Reverend Monsignor, last year.

Catholic men who receive Holy Communion on the First Friday attend the luncheon whether members of the Knights of Columbus or not according to Urban Kress, co-chairman.

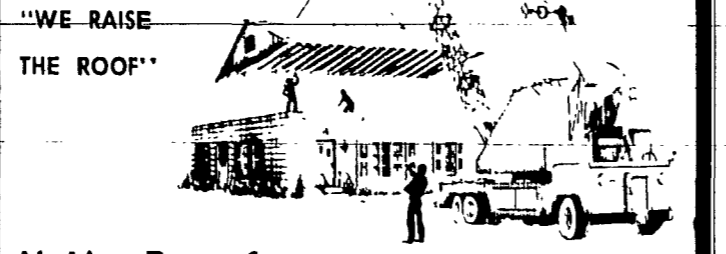
