

Priests in Other Areas Celebrate Silver Jubilees

Father Terence Cauley, a native of Rochester, and an alumnus of St. Andrew's Seminary here, entered the Franciscan Novitiate at Paterson in 1936.

Ordained May 28, 1942, at the National Shrine, Wash., D.C., he received his B.A. degree from St. Bonaventure University, Class of '42, and after serving for a year at St. Francis Friary, New York City, was sent to the Seraphic Seminary, Callicoon, N.Y. In 1945, he was transferred to St. Joseph's Friary, Wilkes-Barre, Pa. where he has been engaged in various pastoral activities for the past twenty-two years.

In the parish he is the Choir Director, Director of St. Anthony Devotions, and C. D. teacher. He is Chaplain and member of the Board of the Youth Settlement House and Camp, Wilkes-Barre Township.

He has served as Regional Vocational Director for the Scranton Diocese and for Holy Name Province. Since the beginning of Vatican II he has been actively engaged in Regional Liturgical Workshops and has had a leading role in Ecumenical programs.

Father Terence will have a celebrated Mass of Thanksgiving for his Jubilee at St. Joseph's Friary, Wilkes-Barre, on Sunday, May 28, at 4:30 p.m. Father Callistus Smith, O.F.M., will preach and Fathers Theophane Larkin, O.F.M., Daniel O'Rourke, O.F.M., James Dowle, C.S.C., William Osterle, S.J. will be concelebrants.

A Jubilee Mass in Rochester will be at St. Andrew's Church, Valentine, at 4:30 p.m. Father Valentine Long, O.F.M., will preach. Fathers Benedict Emmann, William Charbonneau, Paul Wohlrab, and James Marvin, concelebrating.

Father R. Mansfield Starks, pastor of St. Joan of Arc Church, Menands, N.Y., a native of Rochester, will observe his Silver Jubilee in the Priesthood with a Mass of Thanksgiving at 12 noon in his church on May 28.

Father Starks who is also Diocesan Supervisor of Cemeteries in the Albany diocese will be assisted by his brother Father Donald L. Starks, also a Rochester native, as deacon. Father

William F. Jilinsky will be sub-deacon.

Rev. Joseph J. Weber will be archpriest, and Rev. John F. Connolly will be master of ceremonies. The sermon will be preached by the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Howard F. Manny. A reception will be held in the afternoon in the parish rectory.

On the actual anniversary day, Father Starks will offer a Solemn Mass in St. Isaac Jogues Chapel, Saratoga Lake.

Father Starks was ordained on May 30, 1942 at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Albany, by Bishop Gibbons.

Father Starks served as assistant at Albany, Canajoharie and Schenectady, prior to being

named Assistant Diocesan Supervisor of Cemeteries and Chaplain at Mount St. Joseph Convent, Castleton in 1960. He was appointed administrator of the Menands parish in 1961 and became pastor in 1963. He was named Diocesan Supervisor of Cemeteries in 1962.
