GAZA: THE BLIND SEE
THE HOLY FATHER'S MISSION AID TO THE ORIENTAL CHURCH

IF YOU LIVED THERE YOU COULD WASH THEIR FACES
An expectant mother in the Gaza Strip prays her baby will not be blind. If the baby is born healthy, she knows now at least how to protect its vision. . . . And in Gaza even blind children can have a future now. Seven years ago they were sentenced to beggary in dirty, sun-baked streets. Today they come by school-bus to the Pontifical Mission Center to learn a lifetime trade. . . . Work for the blind, Pope Paul says, is "one of the highest forms of Christian love." In Gaza, our 76 blind boys and girls are all Muslims. God asks you to share His love with them. . . . How can you share His love? If you lived in Gaza you could wash these children's faces, perhaps even teach the ABCs. Now at least, praying we can continue, you can walk to the corner mailbox. . . . The Center, Gaza's only school for the blind, was built in 1960 by readers of this column. To keep it in operation costs \$2,166 a month.
