Gregorian Institute Lists Noted Musician, J. Grady

The Gregorian Institute's first diocesan-sponsored liturgical music seminar scheduled to be conducted at St. John Fisher College August 29 to Sept. 1 will be open to all diocesan church music teachers, organists and music supervisors, and those from surrounding dioceses. Requests for information have already been received from 37 states and from Canada. Present indications point to a well-attended session.

Among the prominent Institute faculty members who will lecture during the three-day conference will be the well-known New York musician John Grady, who is distinguished not only for his achievements as music director at the United Nations Holy Family Church, which was visited by Pope Paul on his visit to the United Nations in October, 1965, but also for the position he holds as official organist of the Metropolitan Opera, Lincoln Center.

Grady will give an intensive course in Church Organ Style and Parish Service Playing emphasizing the following: Background necessary for the modern Catholic Church musician; knowledge of repertoire and style appropriate for the church service; norms of selection; improvisation and compositional devices; conducting both independently and at the keyboard.

Service playing; how to play hymns effectively; how and what to play at weddings and funerals; how to use the organ at the Sunday High Mass; at the Sunday Low Mass; what to do about "filler" music; how to accompany a choir and a congregation; an exploration of the various chants, psalms, motets that an organist would encounter and how to accompany them.

Other lecture and demonstration courses will include the treatment of such important subjects as the Musical Reformation of Vatican II by the Rev. Richard Wojcik of the Archdiocesan Music Commission of Chicago; Verna Canto and Choir Rehearsal Procedures by Wayne Belton, prominent clinician of the Gregorian Institute staff; and Speech Diction and Choral Technique coordinated with reading sessions of new

materials by the Rev. Daniel Reunin of Hartford, Conn.
