20 Private Pools Open To CYO Swim Classes

Thanks to the generosity of many private pool owners, the Rochester Catholic Youth Organization will conduct summer swimming classes for boys and girls ages five and up in 20 outdoor pools. Registrations are now being accepted for these classes.

Instruction is to be offered at all skill levels with particular emphasis given to non-swimmers. Classes are limited in size to insure the best possible teaching conditions and all lessons are to be taught by American Red Cross water safety instructors and aides. At the conclusion of each eight lesson course students receive signed progression cards and swim suit badges in recognition of the progress made.

Lifesaving classes have been scheduled and special adult lessons are also to be conducted for non-swimmers as well as those requiring instruction in more advanced phases of swimming and diving. The purpose of this program is to make swimming instruction and knowledge of the elements of water safety readily accessible by offering such training at neighborhood locations.

Nuns List Reading Laboratory in Auburn

The Auburn Branch Reading Laboratory of Catherine McAuley College, Rochester, will be conducted for the second summer in conjunction with a Federal Economic Opportunity Program.

Sister Mary Rosaria, a faculty member of Cardinal Mooney High School in Rochester, and for the past sixteen years Director of the Summer Reading Laboratory at Holy Family School, Auburn, will be the administrator of this Community Action Program for Schools participating in Cayuga County.

Under this program there will be 12 teachers, 4 aides, a secretary and 200 educationally deprived children whose ages range from first grade through junior high school level.

This program will be run in conjunction with the regular summer program at Holy Family School.

Pupils will receive remedial and development work in reading, mathematics and English skills, in one hour classes for each respective subject, with eight students to a class.

The new math will be taught for students grades 3 through 8. A special reading comprehension course for junior high school pupils is also part of the summer program.

For diagnostic and placement purposes a complete testing program is built around the areas of intelligence, personality and reading achievement. Test results are discussed in special interviews with parents.

Registration for the regular Summer Program is now open with daily registration at Holy Family School, 83 North St., Auburn. Students of all de-
