## Elmira Committee Formed To Study Merger Plans

A recommendation to appoint a committee for further study of the proposed merger of St. Peter and Paul's and St. Cecilia's School in Elmira was made at the June meeting of the Chemung County Catholic School Board.

The recommendation was made after it was seen that the merger would be difficult to implement effectively in the short time remaining until September, especially since four recommendations made to the diocesan education office could not be met.

The recommendations were that the pupil per room ratio be limited to no more than 40 pupils, that two more teaching Sisters be assigned (since this was to be a pilot program), that the Sister-principal be freed from teaching, and that the agreement be on an annual basis, with either participant capable of withdrawing at any time.

The only recommendation granted by the diocesan office was the assignment of a non-teaching principal; it was felt by diocesan education officials that the local schools themselves would have to implement the rest of the program.

Both school boards (St. Cecilia's and St. Peter and Paul's) had voted to approve the merger, provided the recommendations could be met.

## Dennis J. Keenan Funeral, Victim of Vietnam War

Funeral Mass for Sgt. Dennis J. Keenan, who died in combat near Da Nang in South Vietnam, was offered by Monsignor Leo V. Smith in Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, June 15.

The 24-year-old son of Mrs. Maurice (Margaret) Keenan died in action serving in the First Squadron of the 9th Cavalry Division.

## Scot Raps Ecumenism

Edinburgh — (RNS)—Modern ecumenical leaders, particularly in the World Council of Churches, were sharply attacked for alleged loss of faith and wrong priorities over unity by the moderator of the Free Church of Scotland.

The Rev. Murdoch MacLeod of Tarbat told the General Assembly that the cry for unity was loudest from those who had lost all that made a people worthy of the name Christian. He also claimed that the Churches foremost in the ecumenical movement had lost faith in the fundamental doctrines of Scripture.

The leaders of modern ecumenism, and one thinks particularly in the World Council of Churches, "appear to have succumbed to the idea that the Church should reflect the trends and duplicate the evolution of political and commercial systems."

Mr. MacLeod claimed the World Council of Churches had a humanitarian philosophy as a substitute for the Christian faith and discouraged missionary endeavors of the old evangelical type.

Among his survivors is a brother, Richard E. Keenan, who was wounded in the Korean War while serving with the Army.

Also surviving are his daughter, Karen Keenan, sister, Mrs. William (Maureen) Work, five nieces, seven nephews, one uncle and aunt.

High Priest Amram Hachoen, 76, the spiritual leader of the small Samaritan sect, reported here that none of the 237 members of his community at Nablus was injured during the recent war between Israel and Jordan.

Nablus is in formerly Jordanian territory now held by Israel, near Mount Gerizim which the Samaritans consider sacred.

The high priest was welcomed enthusiastically by the 170-member Samaritan community here on his first visit to Tel Aviv since 1948. The two communities are believed to be the only survivors of the ancient Biblical Samaritans, most of whom were wiped out in 67 A.D. when the Roman Emperor Vespasian conquered Samaria and killed 11,000 of its inhabitants.

High Priest Amram Hachoen, who claims to be the 146th direct descendant of Aaron, brother of Moses, is the spiritual leader of the sect, which differs from other Jewish groups chiefly in that it accepts only the first five books of the Old Testament and has different rituals for the observance of Passover.
