

# Fr. Gorman Describes Tour Set for October

A three-week tour of Europe by air will be directed by Father Joseph Gorman of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish, Rochester.

The tour will depart by transatlantic jet on Oct. 12 and will



cover the principal scenes of cultural and spiritual interest in Portugal, Spain, France, Switzerland, and Italy. It will enter Europe at Lisbon and, after a thorough city tour, proceed to Fatima.

A small village north of Lisbon, Fatima is the site of what have been called the most extraordinary and best attested of all the recorded apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

People are still living who were in the crowd of some 70,000 that witnessed the gyrations of the sun nearly fifty years ago, on Oct. 13, 1917, the day of the final apparition.

Father Gorman and his companions will participate in the golden jubilee observances before they fly to Madrid.

After several days in Madrid they will drive to the magnificent Valley of the Fallen and nearby El Escorial. Then they will fly over the Catalonian Mountains to Barcelona, from where they will be escorted to Montserrat, an ancient Benedictine monastery and pilgrims' shrine.

Near Montserrat they will come to Manresa, where they will visit the cave to which St. Ignatius Loyola retired when he wrote his famous Spiritual Exercises.

Over the Pyrenees Father Gorman's party will travel by train to Lourdes, there to take part in special devotions with thousands of other pilgrims from all over the world.

Arriving in Paris by train, the band will embark upon a detailed tour of the city and its

dozens of historic landmarks. An entire afternoon will be spent at Versailles.

"We hope to see everything," said Father Gorman, "from the Eiffel Tower to Montmartre and its splendid Basilica of Sacre Coeur. But I have also reserved enough time to sit and relax in one of the traditional sidewalk cafes."

Over the majestic snow-capped peaks of the Alps, the party will fly to the fairytale city of Venice, there to join thousands of other strollers in the colorful streets and to ride in the gondolas.

By private motorcoach the visitors will drive to Florence, out to Pisa to climb the leaning tower, then southward through the heart of Italy.

"Italy has more faces than any other country in Europe," says Father Gorman. "They include those of the Roman empire and the renaissance; those of grand opera, industry, and fashion; and those of sun, lakes, and mountains."

"The capital of these many Italies is Rome. Bathed in its rosy golden light, it is both stylish and rich. It is the Eternal City. Throw a coin into the fountain of Trevi and, legend has it, you will certainly return one day."

"Rome is packed with monumental and significant sites,"

said Father Gorman, "and we intend to visit just about every one of them."

"But the Vatican itself will be the focal point of our interest. We have scheduled guided tours of every part of it available to us. Of course, the highlight will be our audience with the Pope."

The catacombs, squares, historic edifices, and major basilicas will be examined by the group under the guidance of veteran Roman tour conductors, according to Father Gorman.

"We want to allow time to visit our friends among the priests, nuns, and students assigned to Rome," he said.

"We hope to take in an opera, too, or perhaps one of the musical productions in the open air theater at the Baths of Caracalla."

For a taste of Switzerland the group will fly to Lucerne and drive through some of the world's most dazzling scenery to the great baroque monastery of Maria Einsiedeln. The travelers will fly home from Zurich on Nov. 2.

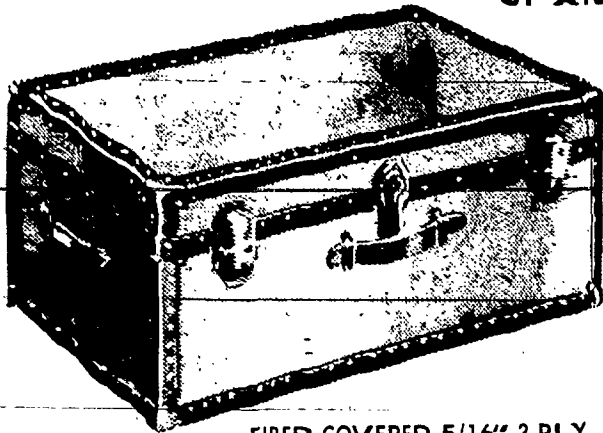

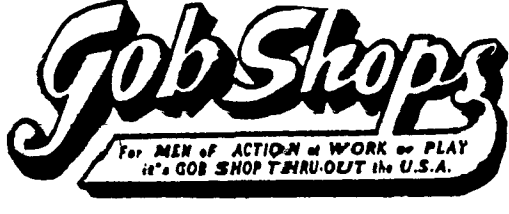

## Pharmacy Course at St. Mary's

Special training courses in hospital pharmacy will be offered at St. Mary's Hospital for retail pharmacists as part of a national program to meet the increased demands on health professions brought about by Medicare and Medicaid programs.

Ralph McGarrity, head of the pharmacy at St. Mary's Hospital, said the traineeship program was sponsored by the American Society of Hospital Pharmacists under a grant from the National Pharmaceutical Council.

The growing demand for pharmacists is anticipated because Medicare and Medicaid regulations require that all extended care facilities be covered by a pharmacist, but there are not enough hospital pharmacists to meet these needs.

McGarrity said that retail pharmacists in the Rochester area who are interested in taking the courses may write him at St. Mary's Hospital for information.
