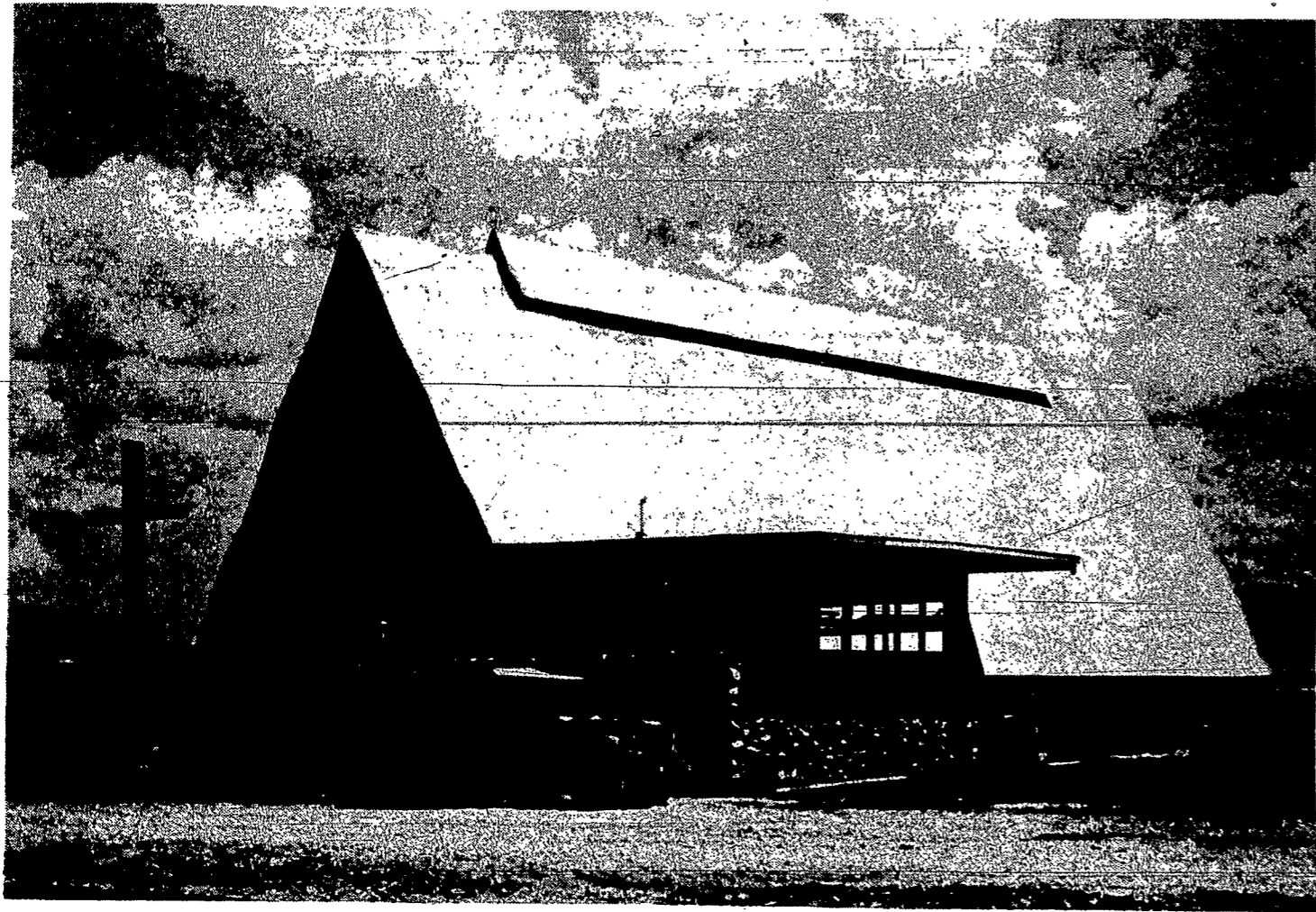
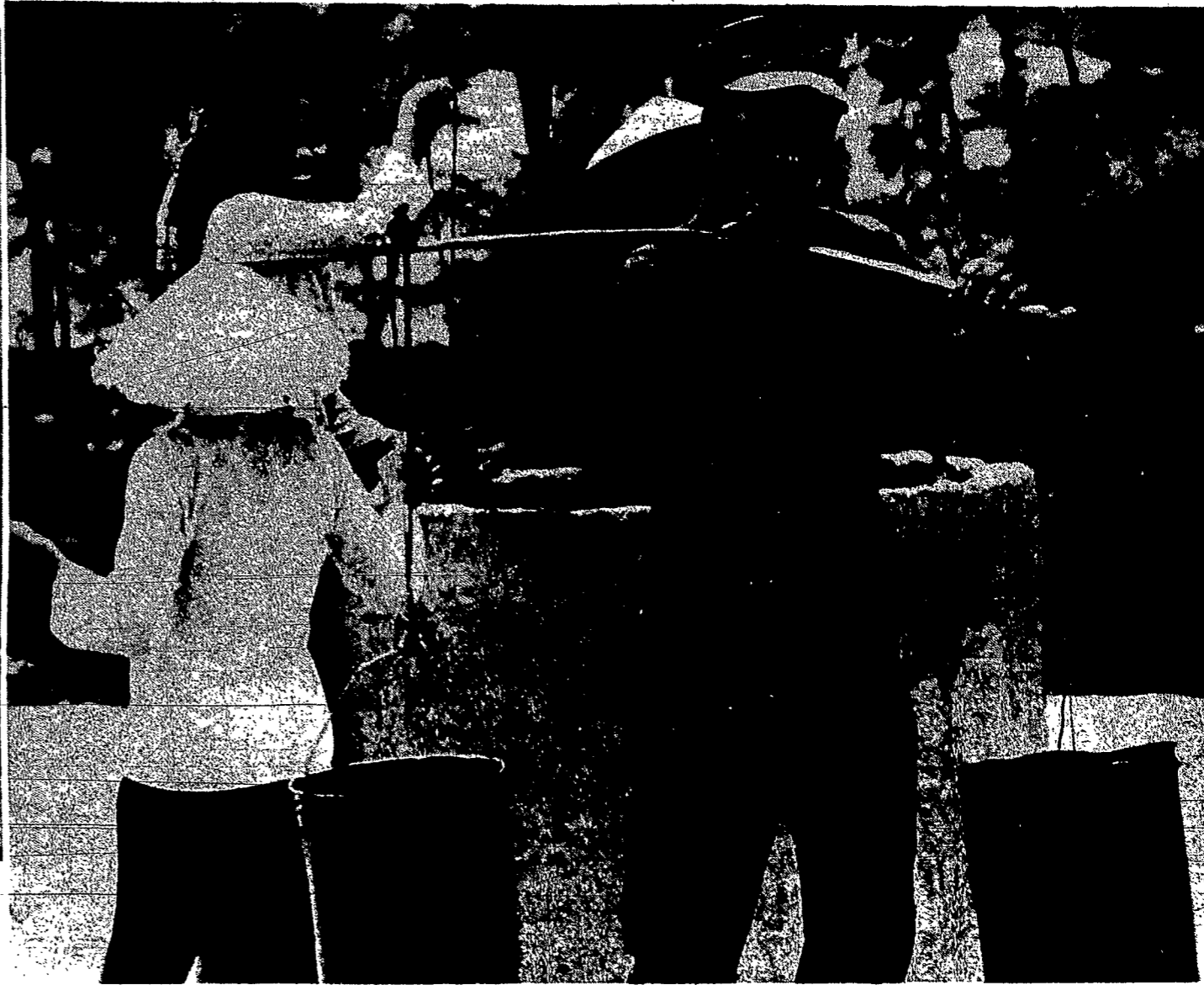


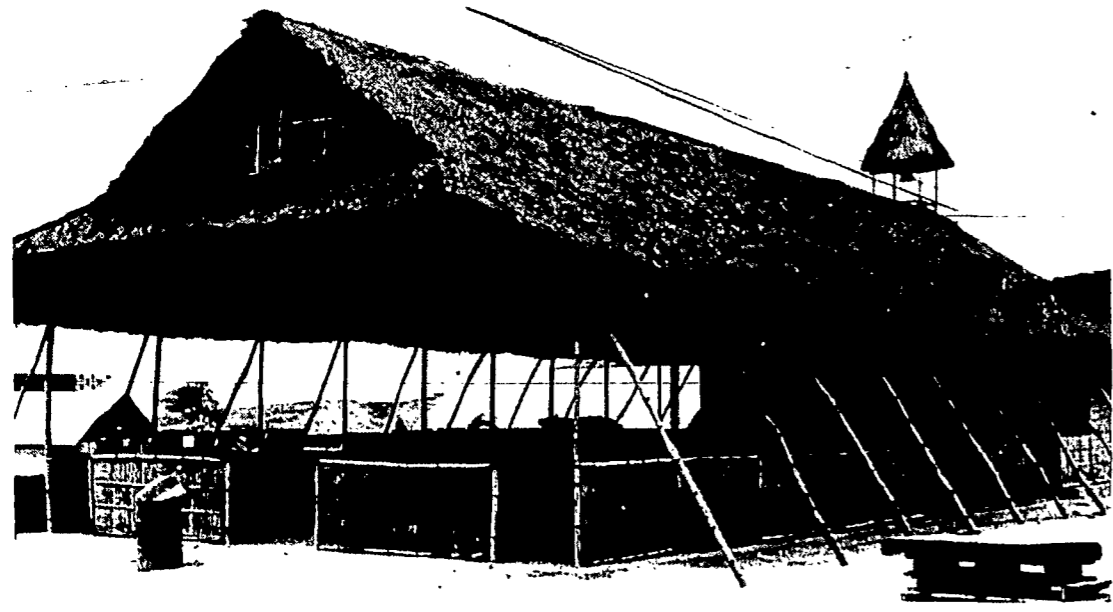
Seabees Build Faith, Friendship in Vietnam



G.I.'s in Vietnam, at least at Chu Lai, will have a chapel quite like at home, thanks to Seabee work crews.



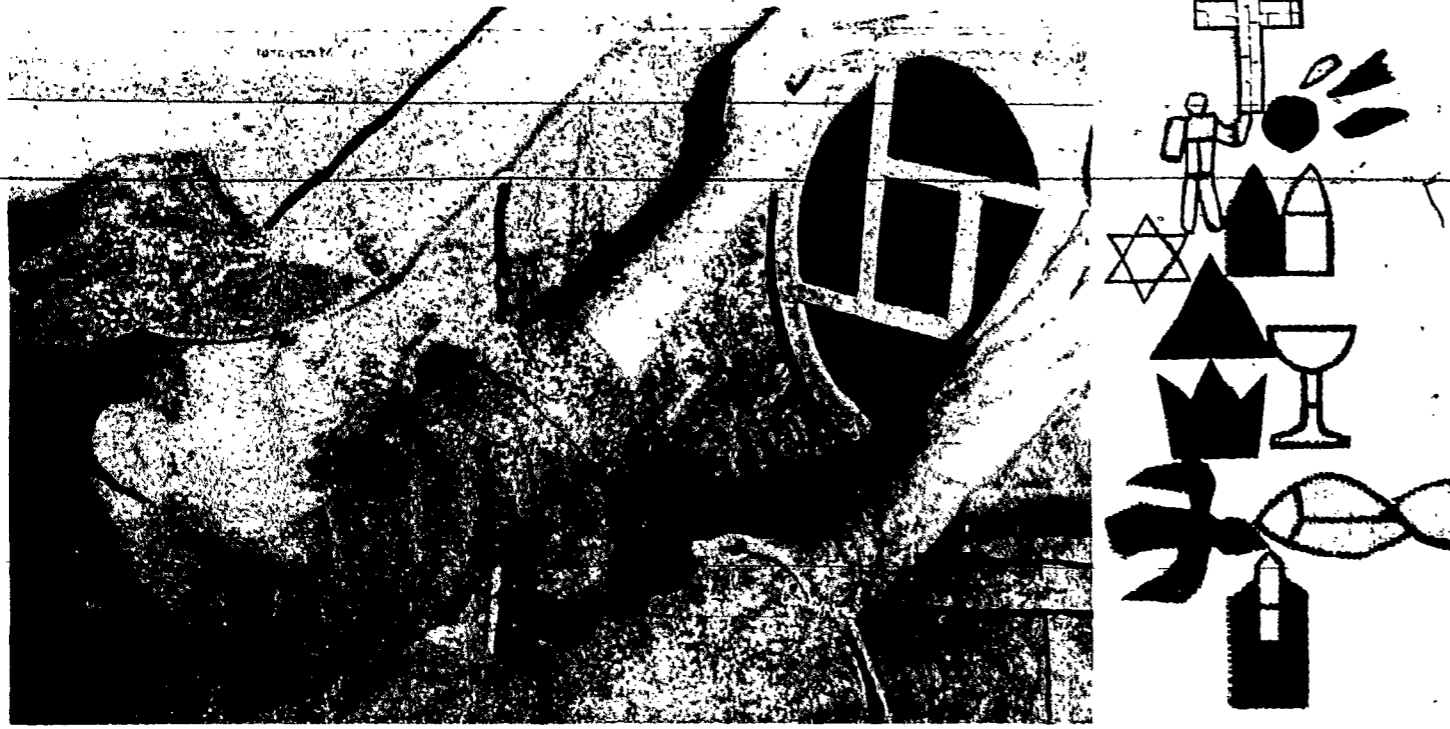
Seabee Richard Stapleman helps Vietnamese rebuild their war-wrecked village near Chu Lai.
