

The Holy Spirit in The Church

The Association of Chicago Priests sent a mailing to all priests asking them to check off from a list of twenty-five problematic areas...

I have yet to meet anyone who did not believe in the need for authority...

The problem arises because the Council has theoretically or theoretically-assented to a form that has not been in use for many centuries.

I shall present my case by taking four passages from the Constitution on the Church...

"The entire body of the faithful, anointed as they are by the Holy One, cannot err in matters of belief..."

"Alloting his gifts to everyone according as He wills, He distributes special graces among the faithful of every rank."

"They (bishops) understand

that it is their noble duty to shepherd the faithful and to recognize their ministries and charisms."

"They (the laity) should openly reveal to them their needs and desires with that freedom and confidence which is fitting for children of God and brothers in Christ..."

The first passage says that infallibility resides in the entire Church, not simply in the Pope

or even the Pope and all the bishops. This is the teaching of St. Augustine and even Cardinal Newman who wrote an essay, "On Consulting the Faithful in Matters of Doctrine."

If infallibility is in the entire Church, the teaching church must shift gears and become the listening church. Patriarch Maximus used this argument in a famous intervention on birth control early in the Council...

Let me be quick to add a disclaimer. I am not saying that the Council is advocating a Gal-

lop poll morality, nor was the Patriarch. The point is that here is where we begin in assessing a situation. The Holy Spirit speaks through the entire Church. Maybe the fact that we did not do enough consulting is part of the reason why we are in a bind on the birth control issue.

The second and third quotations referred to the Holy Spirit's allotting his gifts to the faithful of every rank and the duty of bishops (I would add priests) to recognize these charisms.

Everything was neat and clear before. The Holy Spirit worked his way down the organizational chart in the chancery of

of Commerce, a Parish discussion or CFM group or a civil rights group.

Anybody can see that the Council, in admitting the dispersion of the gifts of the Holy Spirit outside canonical channels, creates disorder. I just hope that we will never again have the kind of order we had in the pre-conciliar church...

Now the Council is saying something different. The Holy Spirit might come in a special way to Mrs. Murphy's boarding house, Joe's Tavern, the UAW Solidarity House, the Chamber
