Coach Bob Rosmarino, starting his 3rd season at the Dewey Avenue school, has some stand-out returnees from last year's fine 6-2 club. If he can fill some of the holes left by graduation, his Little Irish could again walk off with the Catholic League title.

Favored with depth and experience, Aquinas intends to use a two-rotation system this year. By using two teams, Aquinas can exploit its rich talents at the better-endowed positions.

In this game, two quarterbacks are twice as good as one. It looks from here as though few high schools can match the double punch of John Parinello and Doug Miller. Parinello is a smooth operator while Miller provides a strong running threat.

At the halfback spots, Rosmarino is in good shape. He's got Bruce Costello and Kevin DeKond. "Both boys have put on weight this summer and look stronger than ever," says the Irish coach. "We're hoping they live up to the promise they showed last fall," he said. At fullback is a solidly-built junior, Gerry Fess.

Up front, the Little Irish are in clover at center and guard, ready at tackle and hopeful at end. At center Wayne Bowser is the proudest product. He's six

Elmira — Notre Dame High School will open its '67 football campaign tomorrow (Sept. 16) at Corning West, and will try to keep intact its all-woman loss grid record with that opponent. A veteran line and a relatively untried backfield will take the field for the Crusaders under new coach Jerry Everling.

Everling's main task at Notre Dame in the upcoming 1967

season will be the rebuilding of a depleted backfield.

Notre Dame lost all of its 1966 backfield through the graduation of quarterback Paul Titus, halfbacks Pete DeSocio and Gary Mordough and all-city captain Joel Ramich. These places will be filled by halfbacks Fran Pirozzolo and Charlie Cascio.

Duke Carroll will be the kicker and has an excellent chance of starting at halfback. Don Perfetti will also see action. Quarterback is still up for grabs between junior John Harris and Pete Perfetti. Fullback is in the capable hands of all-city co-captain Bill Baker.

At guards will be the all-city tandem of Augie Moretti and Dan O'Herron, with John DeLaura waiting in the wings. The center will be junior Dan Farrell. One tackle will be Hank Cesari; the other slot will be fought over by John Miranda and two promising juniors Pat MacNamara and the hustling Mark Post up after a fine JV season.

The ends will be Eddie Knott, Kevin Frawley, and Fran Essen.

Two sophomores qualified to make this year's squad are linebacker Mike VanWert and fleet halfback Harvey Pugh.

Everling, who at Rush-Henrietta for two seasons, posted an 11-3 mark, will have 10 lettermen returning for his first year at ND.
