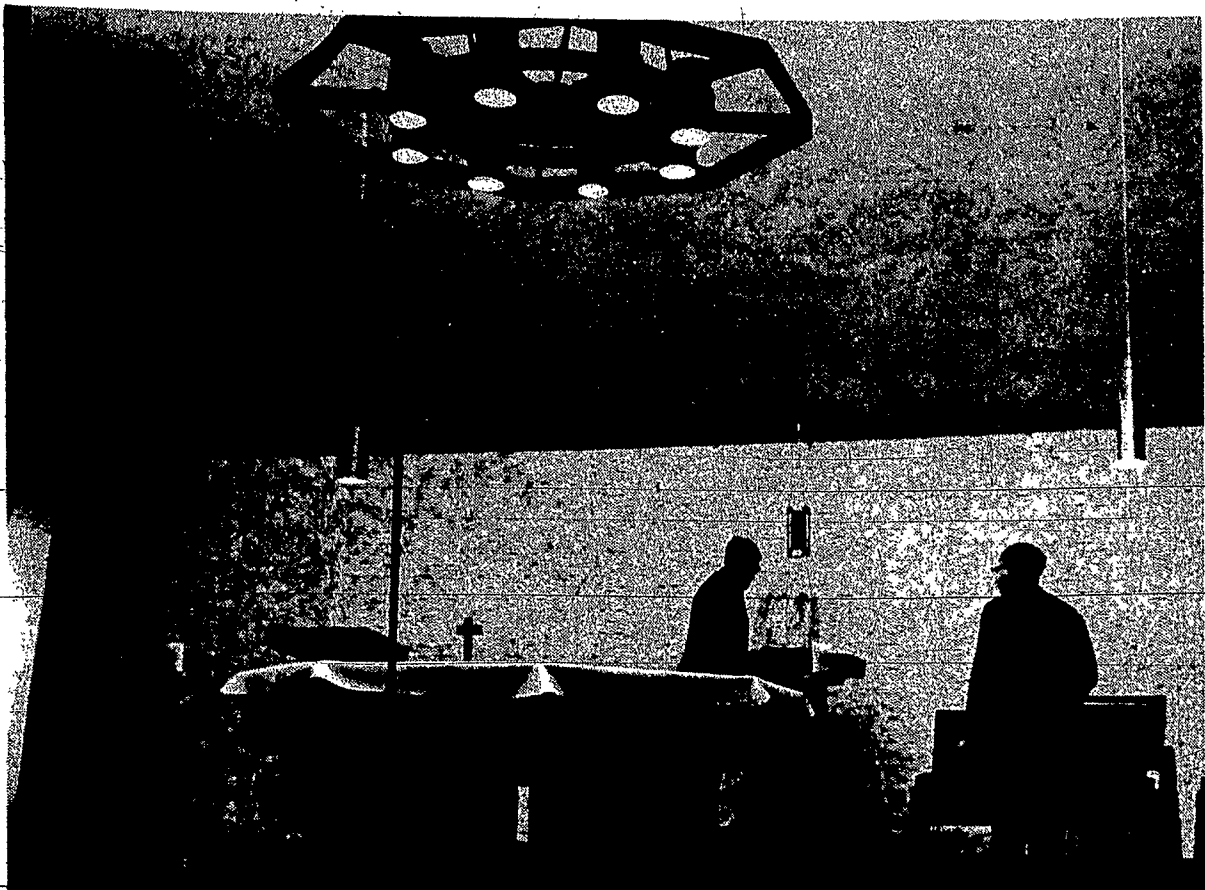


The New Becket Hall

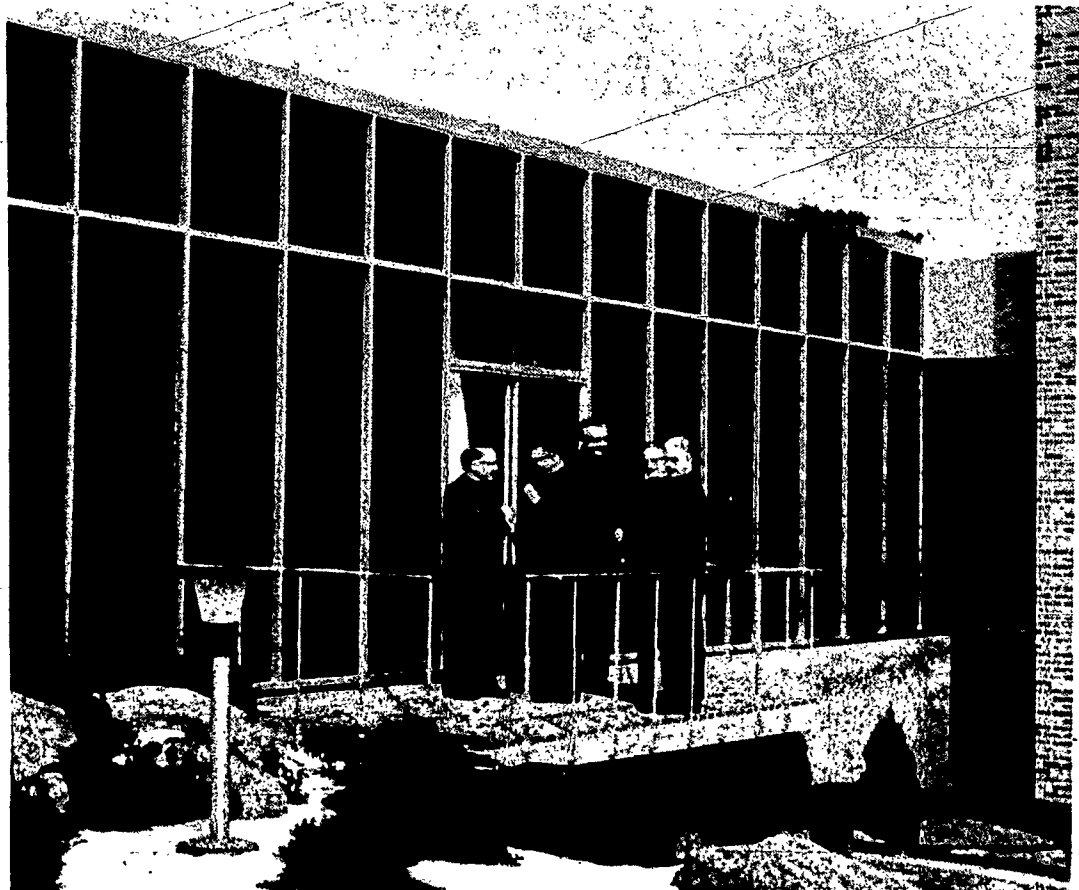

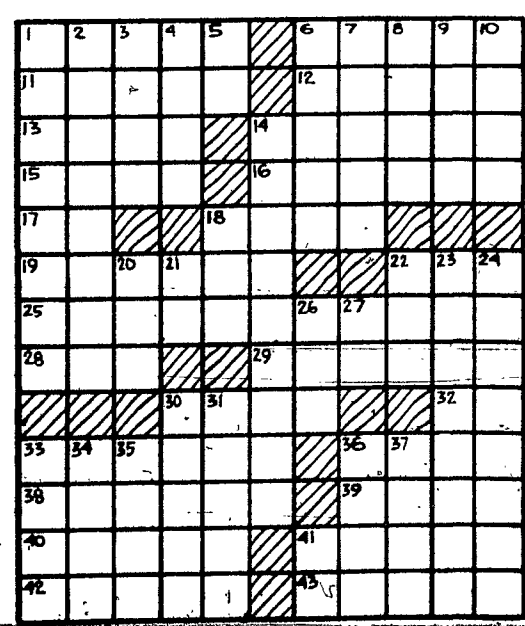
