

Population Symposium To be on WHEC Radio

WHEC Radio will broadcast the symposium "Population Progress and the Twentieth Century" in its entirety in a series of special hour-long programs over a period of nine consecutive nights.

First broadcast of the symposium will be tonight, Friday, from 10 to 11 p.m. The speaker will be Jesuit Father Dexter L. Hanley, whose topic is "Public Policy and Population." Father Hanley will be the first

speaker at the symposium this evening at McQuaid Auditorium. WHEC plans to tape the address of each participant throughout the weekend and these talks will be scheduled as individual hour programs on succeeding nights at 10 p.m. with the concluding panel discussion in which all participants will be heard, to be broadcast Saturday, October 7, 9:30 p.m.
