When Father Whalen was asked by newsmen for his reactilion to the boycott which shunt down Catholic University in April of this year, he said he regretted that it had occurred. However, he looked on it with fav-or.

The boycott was staged by more than 6,000 students and some 600 faculty members who prostested the firing of Father Charles E. Curran, a professor of moral theology. It ended after six days with the priest's reimstatement.

"O Mary, Queen of the skies, glorious patroness of aviation, our prayer rises to you. We are pilots and aviators of the whole world. Launched into voyages through the skies, uniting nations and continents in bonds of solidarity, we wish to be wat-chful and conscious instruments of peace and progress for our mother countries."

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
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
