Aquinas, Mooney Meet At Stadium Sunday

The Cardinals from Cardinal Mooney High School make no bones about the fact that Sunday's game with Aquinas is the big one for them.

Coach Tony Merola has pointed his boys for this game and it is the one that the team and their supporters want more than any other on the win side of the ledger.

The tricky club from Maiden Lane fielded a superlative team last season but lost to Aquinas, 42-20, when the Irish came from behind in a 4 TD third period spurt. Mooney finished second in the Catholic League at season's end.

Aquinas also won the opener in the short series between the two schools, 12-7, in 1965.

Mooney enters Sunday's game hungry for victory. The Cardinals dropped their opener to Elmira Southside, 7-6, in a hard fought game. Last week Mooney lost to Notre Dame of Utica, 21-14. In spite of the losses Mooney boasts a well-balanced team. Quarterback John Waffle may put the Irish pass defense to the test. The Cardinal's running attack will be lead by Dick Parker and Terry Freeman.

Aquinas relies on a heavy ground game built around halfbacks Bruce Costello and Kevin DeHond. Quarterback Rich Parrinello is still nursing an injury and may not be ready Sunday. In this event, Doug Miller will call the signals.

Game time at Aquinas Memorial Stadium is set for 2 p.m.

Voters Must Be Registered

If you are not properly registered to vote, you cannot cast your ballot in the forthcoming Nov. 7 elections. This will be your opportunity to vote on the new State Constitution.

Even those on "Permanent Registration" lists may be ineligible if: 1) They have not voted in the last two years; 2) they have moved to a new address, or 3) they have changed their name, e.g. by getting married.

Make sure that you are registered correctly so that you can express your views on Election Day.

Mustang Stampede Hits DeSales in 59-6 Rout

The DeSales Saints of Geneva were overrun by the Penn Yan Mustangs in the bid for their first win, 59-6. Laden with injuries, the Saints were unable to control the powerful Mustang offense headed by halfback Lee Collins.

DeSales received the opening kick-off but were unable to move the ball. Penn Yan returned the punt fifty yards, got a couple of first downs and scored on Brian Legg's 2 yard pass.

DeSales started a drive, but was stopped on the PY 17 by two penalties. The big plays of the 60 yard drive were a 43 yard pass from Paul Walker to big Bob Marshall and a fine run by Coste Costa. Penn Yan intercepted and took 16 plays to score, again.

DeSales only score came on an end around option to Jim Brennan who fired 40 yards in the air to hit Bob Marshall who wrestled for the ball and the TD. Penn Yan ended the first half with a 51 yard pass score. In the second half, seven of DeSales were out of the lineup, including star QB Paul Walker and All-Conference Cris Powers. But Penn Yan kept its starters in for the whole game and romped as three pass interceptions were converted into TD's. DeSales is now 0-3 for the season.
