Here are some rather different ideas which you might like to try:

Borrowed-from-Boston Filling

3 Maplecrest skinless frankfurters, thinly sliced 1/2 cup baked beans 2 tbsp chopped onion 1 tbsp. chili sauce

Combine all ingredients, mix well, and spread on buns. Wrap individually in aluminum foil and grill about 5 minutes on each side
