

of financial concern, worry about property, and care of the parochial school.

There are also a lay principal of the parochial school and a parish secretary. Thus, Pastor Pomeroy has more time than most Catholic pastors for sermon preparation, study, liturgical services, spiritual counsel and participation in community

Pastor Pomeroy is paid \$7, 500 a year, plus costs of his. spacious home, utilities and car. The Missouri Synod of the Lutheran Church provides health insurance and a pension plan.

A typical day in Pastor Pomeroy's ministry may find him calling on a shut-in, broadcasting over station WELL in a Lutheran Hospital after structing nursing students in medical ethics, counseling with a parishioner, pleading for a park in his community before the Chicago Park District as a representative of the Edgewater, Community Council, meeting with a parish committee and then accompanying his son. It's a busy schedule, like many that Catholic pastors have. Still there are contrasts, especially the ramifications of having a family.
