## Callahan To Discuss Faith, Doubt

Dr. Daniel Callahan, executive editor of *Commonweal*, a Catholic opinion journal edited by laymen, will give a public lecture on "Faith, Doubt and Catholic Honesty" at St. John Fisher College Wednesday, November 22, at 8 p.m. in St. Basil Hall auditorium. Admission is free.

In his talk, he will attempt to bare the roots of the present difficulties concerning faith now being experienced by many

Catholics in spite of the work of the recent Vatican Council, as well as try to explain why the problem of doubt has become so critical for contemporary Christians.

A widely recognized younger generation Catholic intellectual, Dr. Callahan has been influential as a journalist and educator. A graduate of Yale University, he received his M.A. from Georgetown University and his Ph.D. in philosophy from Harvard University, and has taught at Temple University, Brown University, and Union Theological Seminary. He was the first Roman Catholic to be appointed to the Religion faculty at Brown.

Dr. Callahan is the author of *The Mind of the Catholic Layman* (1963), a study of the role of the Catholic layman in American life; *Honesty in the Church* (1965), an analysis of the question of Catholic integrity, private and public; and *The New Church* (1966).

He is also the editor of *Generation of the Third Eye: Young Catholic Leaders View Their Church* (1965); *Federal Aid and Catholic Schools* (1964); *The Secular City Debate* (1966); and a co-editor of *Christianity Divided: Protestant and Roman Catholic Theological Issues* (1961).

Catholic Youth Organization announces its annual Thanksgiving Fun Day for all elementary school members and their school age guests.

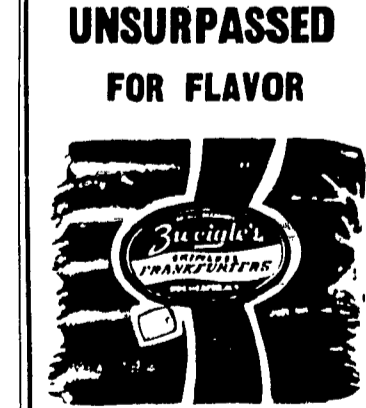

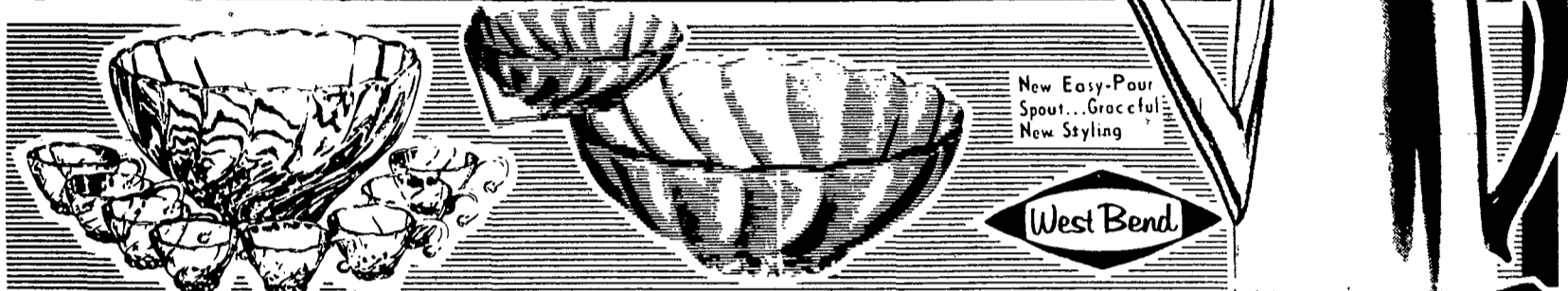
