Cathedral Organists' Work Will Debut in Worcester

The dedication concert of the new Wicks organ at Assumption Preparatory School in Worcester, Mass. on Sunday, Nov. 19, will bring together the Boston Symphony Orchestra, the organ virtuoso Berj Zamkochian, and a young American composer, William Ferris, whose work "Concert Piece for Organ and String Orchestra" will be premiered under his direction.

Francis Poulenc's "Concerto for G Minor" played by amokochian will open the program. Ferris composed his concert piece in memory of Poulenc.

At the age of eighteen, Ferris was appointed organist and choir director of the Holy Name Cathedral, Chicago, Ill., a position he held for seven years. He is now organist and choir director at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Rochester. He is also a member of the Rochester Diocesan Music Commission.

Ferris, a Chicago native, studied at De Paul University School of Music and at the American Conservatory of Music.
