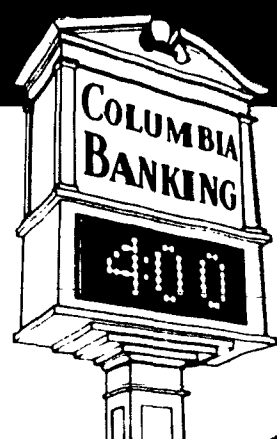
H. E. Fitzgerald Rites in Ohio

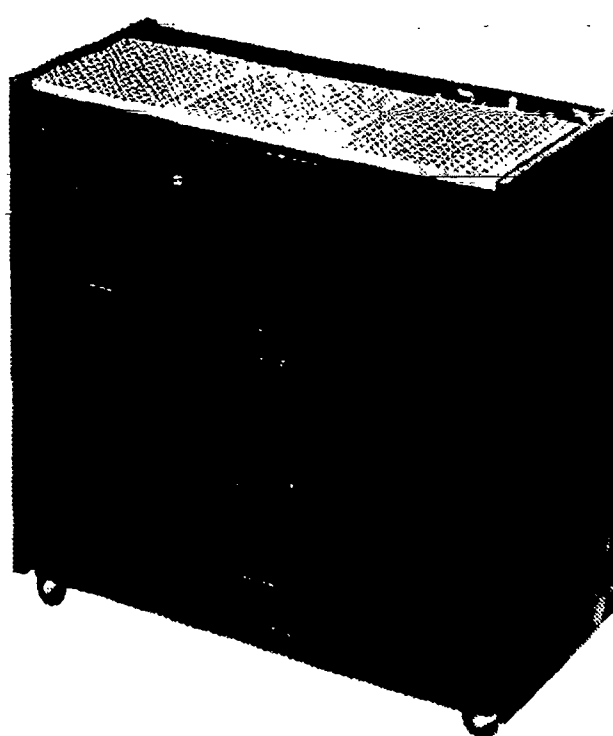

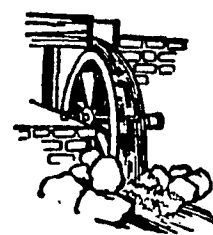
