POP Turkey with Noodles

- 2 cups diced turkey 1/2 cup blanched almonds
- 6 tbls. Land O'Lakes Butter

Some Rochesterians may remember the delicious chicken croquettes once served at the popular Odenbach's. If you still have a yen for this dish, why not concoct your own.... with left-over turkey on hand, you can use this in place of chicken, and the following sauce will add even more to their appeal:

Turkey Croquettes with Fruit Sauce

Croquettes:

- 1 cup milk
- 3 tbls. Blue Bonnet Whipped Margarine
- 2 cups turkey pieces
- 2 tbls. ground onion 2 tsp. lemon juice
- 1 tsp. Worcesterchire sauce
- Dash of pepper
- 1 tsp. salt tbls. sugar
- 1 tbls. Sherry

Breading:

- 2 tbls. milk
- 2 cups bread crumbs

Sauce:

- % cup sugar
- 1-#21/2 can Fruit Cocktail 1/4 tsp. mint extract
- 2 tbls. Sherry

Spud 'n' Nugget Bake

- 4 cups sliced potatoes


