Here's a fruit bread that freezes well and will appeal to those who don't care for the traditional fruit cake:

- 1 1/2 cups dried apricots
1/2 cup water
2 cups granulated sugar
1/4 cup (1/2 stick) LAND O'LAKES BUTTER
2 eggs
4 cups flour
2 tbl. baking powder
1/2 tsp. baking soda
1 tsp. salt
1 1/2 cups orange juice
2 cups finely chopped pecans

Grind or chop apricots; add water and allow apricots to soak for a few minutes (if you grind them in your blender, add water immediately). Drain Cream Butter, and add sugar. Stir in eggs and beat well.
