only true direction of human progress."

He gave another reason: "We do so because peace is part and parcel of the Christian religion, since for a Christian to proclaim peace is the same as to announce Jesus Christ." Here he cited St. Paul in substantiation: "He is our peace" (Eph. 2, 14).

In stating that true peace can come "only from the Gospel," he implied that "true humanism" is evangelical.

"In the end, it is only from the Gospel that there can spring forth true peace, not in order to make men dull and soft, but to replace the impulses of violence and bullying in their minds by the manly virtues of reasoning and the heart characteristic of true humanism."

As his final reason for harping on peace he gave his fear of being "rebuked by God and by history for having kept silence in the face of the danger of a new conflagration."

The Catholic celebration of a Day of Peace on Jan. 1 "must not change the liturgical calendar, which reserved New Year's day for the veneration of the divine motherhood of Mary and the most holy name of Jesus."

In summoning Catholics to celebrate New Year's day as a Day of Peace, he exhorted them to wield "a singular weapon for peace, that is, prayer."

Not Flight, But Fulfillment

Vatican City — (NC) — Pope Paul VI has told a group of European vocation directors that vocations to the priesthood can be increased among the young if the concept of the nature of the priesthood is presented clearly.

In a letter to the second congress of national directors of vocations in Europe, meeting in Rome, the need for self-denial and discipline which is implicit in the priestly vocation was stressed.

The letter was signed by Amleto Cardinal Cicognani, Papal Secretary of State, and expressed the Pope's regrets that

he could not receive the congenial nature of the priest-hood. "It is necessary that the genuine nature of the priest-hood be placed in the proper light. Ecclesiastical vocations are today becoming rarer because the life of the priest and of the sacred ministry are described as different from what they actually are.

"Even certain Catholics do not understand this ministry in its right meaning, but [speak of it] almost as a flight from the world. It can then happen that laymen, after the [Second Vatican] Council has exalted and reaffirmed their role, may

be regarded as more perfect far as human nature is concerned and more effective in the sphere of the apostolate than the priests themselves.

"On the contrary, if the concept of the nature of the priesthood is perfectly clear to a young man he will always consider the priestly ministry as a higher fullness of life. In fact, the priest has a grace which cannot be compared to any other—that of being the living image of Christ and of acting in His name in the world in order to give men the grace of Christ."

'Soup and Bread' Banquet Raises Millions

Bagota, Colombia — (NC) — More than 600 persons attended a \$350 plate "Soup and Bread" banquet here for the benefit of the social work and housing programs of Father Rafael Garcia-Herreros, C.F.M.

The seventh annual Banquet of a Million, so named because of its million peso (\$70,000) goal, raised over three million pesos (\$210,000).

The social works of Father Garcia-Herreros began in 1954 with a television program he entitled the Minute of God. Since then, with the help of an increasing number of benefactors, several housing projects have been financed. One is the Minute of God development named after the television program.

Father Garcia described his project, saying:

"Seven years ago I saw that the poor needed decent housing, so I went on TV to get money and we built houses. Then I saw that houses without schools can't solve the problems of poverty so I went back to TV and we built schools. Then I saw that houses and schools without work were not enough either, so we built cooperative stores and shops. Then I saw that houses and schools and work without discipline was nothing. So we organized the city into a cooperative effort with strict obligations on all."

The funds collected this year will be used for the construction of 500 new homes in a similar community which will be named for the International Eucharistic Congress to be held here next year.
