Research Grant At Nazareth

Biology students at Nazareth Academy are working on a research problem with their teacher, Sister Catherine Ann, through a \$1,000 research grant from the National Science Foundation and the Atomic Energy Commission.

Sister Catherine Ann, who received her Master of Science Degree from St. Bonaventure University, worked at the Texas Woman's University last summer under a NSF research grant. Her work involved the mutagenic effect of CO₆₀ and the gas, octafluorocyclobutane on

the red-pigmented organism, *Serratia marcescens*.

This year, Sister is continuing the research begun during the summer. Sister has selected two biology students Joyce Desmarais and Marcia Marcello, to work with her on the problem through an academic year extension of the NSF research participation.

The research involves checking out a new type of mutant isolated during the summer. This gram negative bacilli which they are studying is

found in water, soil, sewage disposal, and in contaminated foodstuffs. They work Tuesday after school and on Sundays at the school biology laboratory and at the University of Rochester Medical Library.

The money from the foundation is being used for equipment and consumable supplies. This research is under the direction of Dr. Robert Fuerst, professor at Texas Woman's University.

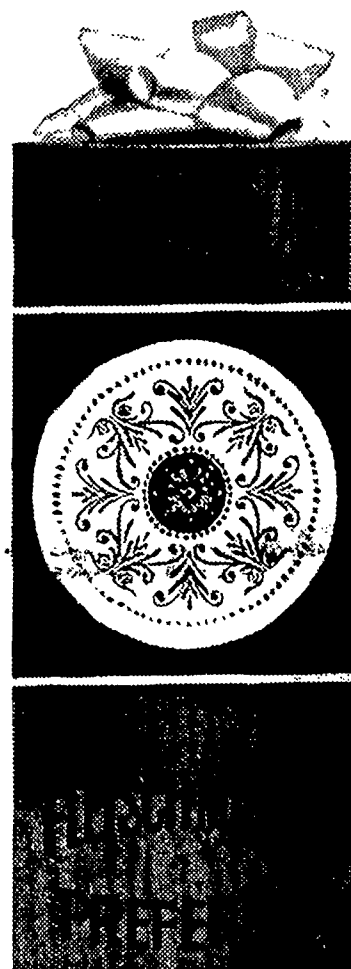

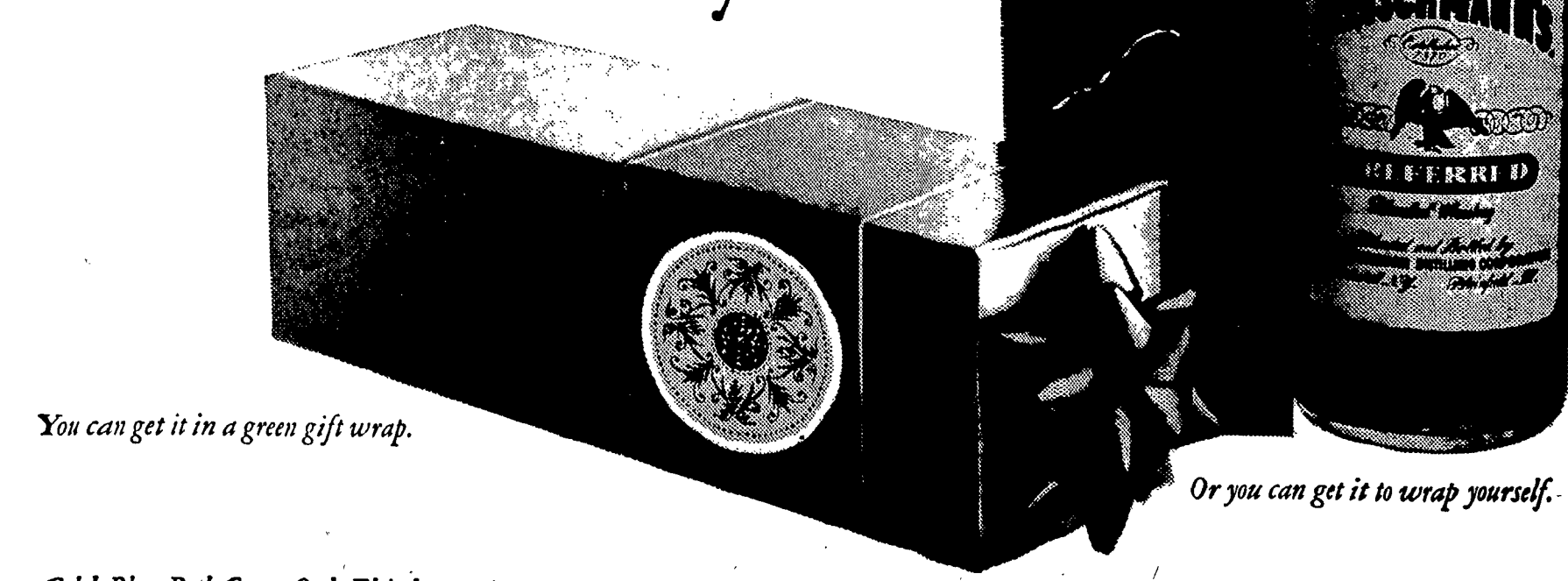
