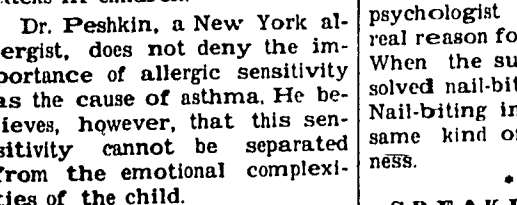

Teachers Aides Fill Vital Role

What's new in Catholic education? An army of volunteers. In the libraries, lunchrooms and offices of Rochester's parochial schools, parents have taken over the chores that used to lengthen and clutter the teachers' day.

"How did we ever get along without them?" one principal rhetorically inquired.

In most of the schools, the volunteers stay out of the classrooms, but teaching is their business at St. Lucy's. The small, elementary school on Troup St. has a staff of tutors recruited by word of mouth from local colleges and suburban parishes...

The pupils "relate beautifully" to him in the words of the principal, Sister M. Josepha, S.S.J. Many of the children have had little attention from home, she explained, and the novelty is enhanced by Mr. Begley's "slight Irish brogue."

Schools in more tranquil neighborhoods have volunteer help in everything but teaching and administration.

"It's the trend — parents are getting more involved," said Sister Marie Rene, S.S.J., principal at Holy Rosary. The need is relatively new, too, she explained. There is more standard testing than there used to be...

The new thing at Holy Rosary is the morning coffee break.

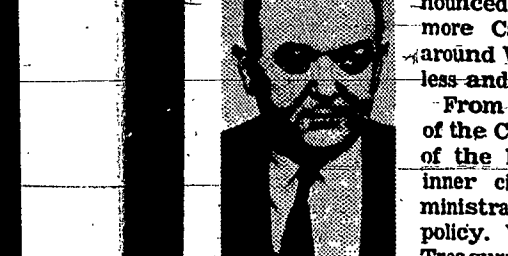

Such questions will spread around the world, because AID is also proposing to give \$2 million to the Government of India for a birth control program...

Only a person whose vision stops at the end of his nose can fail to see that this is going to raise dark suspicions everywhere concerning American motives — and that those suspicions will be exploited to the hilt and American propaganda.
