## Teillard Talks Offered Priests

The direction theology takes in the works of Teilhard de Chardin will be traced in a series of lectures arranged for the continuing education of priests.

Dr. Eulalio Baltazar, author of Teilhard and the Supernatural, will be the speaker. Dr. Baltazar, an associate professor of philosophy at the University of Dayton, studied theology at the Jesuits' Woodstock, Md., College.

The lectures will be given at St. Bernard's Seminary, in the Theology Cycle classroom, from 1:30 to 3:30 Wednesday afternoons. The schedule:

March 6 - Teilhard's World View, a general presentation comparing Teilhard's synthesis with Thomistic and Marxist world-views.

March 13 - The Problem of God, a Teilhardian solution to the problem dealt with by "death-of-God" theologians and secularizers.

March 27 - The Liturgy and Secularity - a discussion of the place of the liturgy in a secular world.

April 3 - The Secularity of Supernatural Grace - a discussion of a new theology of grace and its comparison to the scholastic formulation.

Father David Murphy, vice-rector of St. Bernard's and dean of studies, said a fifth lecture would be added if time permitted. This bibliography of Teilhard's works was suggested by The Divine Milieu, Hymn to the Universe and The Phenomenon of Man.
