Spanish Green Bean Casserole

1/2 cup Blue Bonnet Margarine 1/2 cup chopped onion

- 2 eup chopped celery

Italian Raisin Bread (3 loaves)

- 2 pkg. Red Star Active Dry Yeast
- 1 cup scalded milk ⅓ cup salad oil
- 11/4 cup sugar 6 eggs
- % cup raisins 1 tbl. anise seed
- 2 tbl. lemon extract
- 21/2 lbs, unsifted all purpose flour

In saucepan, cover raisins with cold water and simmer for 15 minutes. Drain, cool, pat dry on absorbent paper. Scald milk, cool to lukewarm dissolve yeast in milk, set aside.

Beat eggs until light and fluffy. Add oil, lemon extract and then sugar gradually. Stir in milk and yeast mixture. In a large pan place flour, raisins and anise seed. Mix well. Make a well in center. Add liquid ingredients and mix thoroughly Knead on a slightly oiled board until smooth and elastic. Cover. Let rise until double in bulk. Divide dough into 3 equal parts. Shape into loaves. Place in three greased 9x5x3 inch bread pans. Cover, let rise again until double in bulk. Bake at 350 F for 45 minutes Remove from gans to cool.

Serve with Land O'Lakes butter.


