Youth Our Only Hope, McKissick Says

Saginaw, Mich.—(NC)—The only hope for a solution to America's racial problems is in the country's "young people who believe that change is possible," Floyd McKissick, director of the Congress on Racial Equality (CORE), said here. The Negro leader was the concluding speaker in a Lenten lecture series on "The Urban Crisis in America" at St. Paul Seminary.

Youth, he said, should also be heard on other questions facing society such as Vietnam.

"The younger generation has a whole lot on the ball and we've got to quit kicking them," he said. "They just mirror the faults we have. We ain't got enough sense to listen to what our young are thinking, singing and reading."

Nine Pupils Win Aquinas Grants

Scholarships to Aquinas Institute valued at more than \$10,000 have been awarded to local eighth grade students for the 1968-69 academic year. It was announced by Father Leon G. Hart, C.S.B., principal of the boys' high school.

The Aquinas grants, applicable for four years, were made to nine students. Four are full-tuition and five are half-tuition scholarships, renewable semi-annually if scholarship marks are maintained.

Aquinas Boy Wins Optimist Oratory Test

Nicholas Reisinger, 15, son of Mrs. Alois J. Reisinger of Dorchester Road and the late Mr. Reisinger, last Sunday won the right to represent Rochester in an Optimist International oratorical contest for boys under 16.

The Aquinas Institute sophomore won the local Optimist Club contest in competition at the Holiday Inn. He will compete in a district contest later in the month, one of a series leading to the national competition in June. The national winner will receive a \$1,000 college scholarship, and three runners-up will receive \$500 in scholarships.

Aquinas Guard Captures Title in Canadian Meet

Aquinas' blue-ribbon Color Guard won the Canadian Open Championship in an international competition held at St. Catherine's, Ontario, last Sunday.

The win brought the total of Aquinas trophies over the 50 mark since 1964 when the unit was formed here.

The Rochesterians took their gold trophy with a score of 95.14 out of a possible 100 points. Sherburne High (Ontario) Guard took second place, while third spot went to West Genesee High of Canastota, N.Y. Besides their new title, the local Guard members are also currently International Color Guard Circuit champions—Eric County champions and Optimist International champions.
