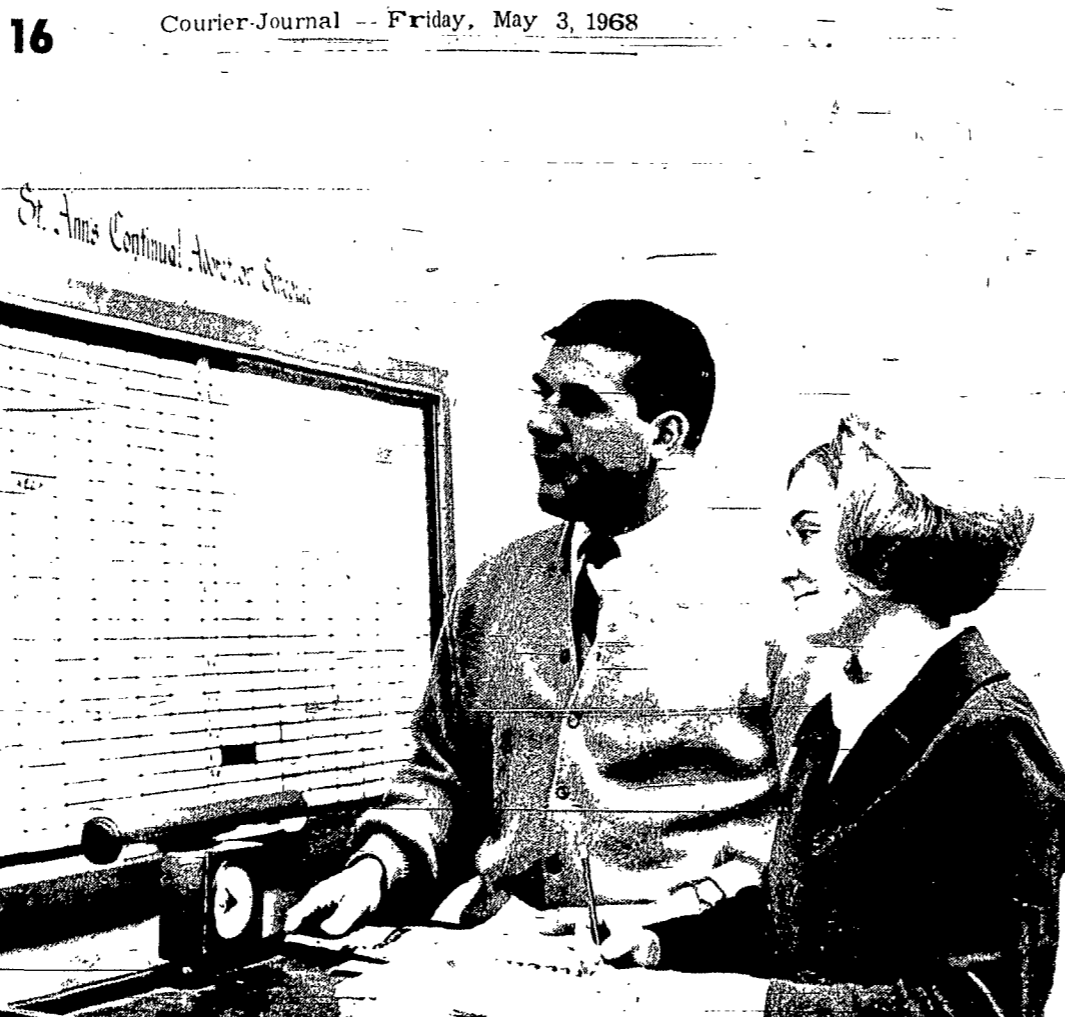

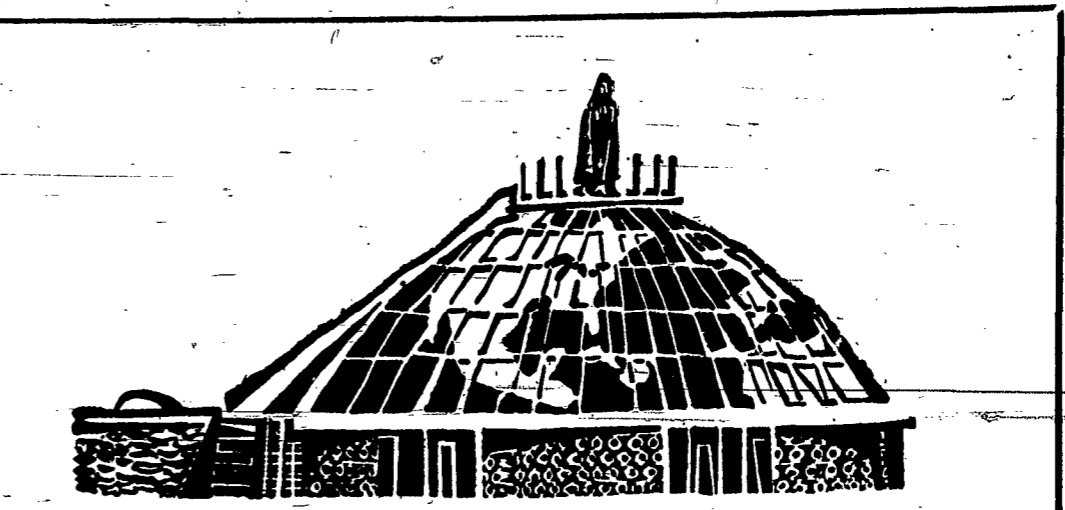
"Catholic Hour" Studies Changes Since Vatican II "The Catholic Hour" will present a series of six weekly programs entitled "The Changing Church" beginning May 5 at 1:30 on the NBC Television Network.

The six half-hour programs will be a study of the significant changes that have taken place in the American Catholic Church during the past 10 years. The first three programs in the series, written by James O'Garra, were filmed in five representative cities in the United States and at the Synod of Bishops in the Vatican in Rome.

The first program on Sunday, May 5, "At the Glassnots" will consider the question: How has the Second Vatican Council's goal of reform and renewal affected the "people of God" in typical American parishes?

Buerkle May Be Big Track Star

An Aquinas Institute graduate of 1965 just may become one of the nation's top distance runners next season. Dick Buerkle, a Villanova junior and a top athlete while at Aquinas, was just a stride behind Pittsburgh's ace, Jerry Richey, who took the two-mile run at the Penn Relays in Philadelphia last Sunday. Richey's 8:46.3 time was only a fraction faster than Buerkle's. Villanova took four Penn Relays events in the annual carnival.

Buerkle is certain to lead Villanova next year, as the Wildcats look for another national collegiate indoor championship. He established the Aquinas record for the mile run in 1966 covering the distance in 4 minutes, 28.3 seconds.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Buerkle of 52 Hursbourne Road, Dick is a member of St. James parish. His younger brother, Joe, is a sophomore at Aquinas and a member of the school's track team.
