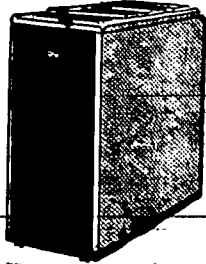

**Blackfriars Schedule 'Carnival'**

Theatergoers who missed the Blackfriars production of Thurber Carnival get three more chances next weekend. This hilarious production of Thurber's bizarre humor will be repeated May 16 and 17 and Sunday, May 19, on the Aquinas stage. Curtain time is 8:30 p.m.

Advertised as a "musical comedy for people who can't sing," this unique production takes the form of a revue, a series of vignettes held together by the varied and competent music of the Tony Caramia trio (Tony Caramia, piano; John Rimore, Bass; Ray Miraglia, drums) as well as the antics of the spacesuit-clad scenery-shifters, Carl Zollo and Stanley Napierala.

The "Carnival," consisting of stories, fables and memoirs, covers the gamut of Thurber creations, from the short, modern version of Red-Riding Hood, "The Little Girl and the Wolf" to the "Secret Life of Walter Mitty."

You'll especially love bouncy, beautiful, petite Bea Petix as the perky little waitress who serves calming cocktails to tired male shoppers during the Christmas rush season; the very proper banker, Wilford Scott, in the role of story teller and dignified inebriated gentleman; strapping Dick Kirsch as the intoxicated Gen. Grant and versatile Richard Mancini, successively portraying a "yippie-type wolf," an "over-indulging shopper," and the extremely demanding self-made hero, Walter Mitty.

Completing the company are Erik Brown Julie Babb, Mary Ellen Sweeney, and general production manager, Jerry Renshaw. The imaginative direction is that of the Blackfriars president, Bill White; the authentic Thurber scenery comes to life at the hands of Carl Zollo.
