**The Eleventh Hour**—by Francis Houtart. (Sheed; \$4.50). A valiant attempt at reconciling the "underground Church" with the Establishment, this book has the objective approach of the sociologist, analyzing the institutional Church and assessing it in the light of the themes of the Second Vatican Council. Radical change, decisive action and revolutionary forces are the conclusions.

**Joy by Louis Evelyn**. (Herder; \$3.50). The joyful heritage of the Christian religion, is immersed in these meditations which concentrate on the "after-Easter stations." The Christian has been commissioned to be a "bearer of glad rejoicing" and this book is designed to help him accept that role.

**Acting on the Word** by Bernard Haring. (Farrar; \$5.95). The spiritual principles that the author enunciates are applicable equally in the life of the layman, but the development of the material is aimed at the putting into practice at the everyday level of religious life.

Hollywood — Violence in films and television which, letters, sermons, speeches and articles do not stop — is being cut sharply in the wake of assassination of Sen. Robert F. Kennedy, and, as one port put it, "some of it must just be lasting."

The TV networks, while still arguing that there is substantial evidence coming from video violence with a life violence, have been slow to react to the nation's recent mood: substituting sermons and switching to work movies when they have been too heavy on violence and promising to either let or greatly lessen violence in future scripts.

In the film industry group of screenwriters, actors have pledged to no longer associate themselves with films that would feature violence for its own sake.
