**Anglican Church Urged to Mull Remarriage Laws**

Oxford, England—(RNS)—A need for the Church of England to re-examine its divorce and remarriage doctrine was emphasized by Canon Arthur R. Winnett, noted Anglican authority on the subject, in a new book published here.

Under present Church of England doctrine a divorced person cannot be remarried in church while the former partner is still living, and anyone who has remarried after divorce may be admitted to Holy Communion only on the recommendation of a priest and at the discretion of the bishop.

Both rulings have produced contentions and controversy within the Anglican Communion. The Anglican Church of Canada overwhelmingly approved a sweeping new canon on the subject last year.

The Canadian canon, which caused a sensation when its passage became known in Britain and also evoked criticism from some Church of England sources, affirms that marriage is a lifelong union but recognizes that not all marriages conform to the standard of union until death.

It then sets out a procedure whereby ecclesiastical matrimonial commissions in all dioceses deal with applications by divorced people who wish to remarry in church while the former partner is still living, and also their admission to Communion.

The commissions would grant or withhold permission after taking all relevant facts into account.

**Monsignor Boland, 'The Labor Priest' Perishes in Fire**

Buffalo—(NC)—Msgr. John P. Boland, 80, known as 'the labor priest' for his pioneering work in the field of labor relations, died here June 30.

The pastor emeritus of St. Thomas Aquinas parish died in a fire in the rectory, where he had served since 1942. Msgr. Boland had been in a wheelchair for most of the last 10 years of his life.

Appointed the first chairman of the New York State Labor Relations Board in 1937, Msgr. Boland held a nationwide reputation for his work in labor relations in the 1930s. He served on the N.Y. State board for five years and was named pastor of St. Thomas Aquinas after his retirement from the board in 1942.

During World War II he spent eight months in Europe doing war relief work and later received the decoration of the Order of William of Orange from Queen Wilhelmina of the Netherlands in recognition of this effort. In 1947, at the request of General Douglas MacArthur, he spent six months in Japan as a consultant to labor organizations there.

**Priest With a Dream**

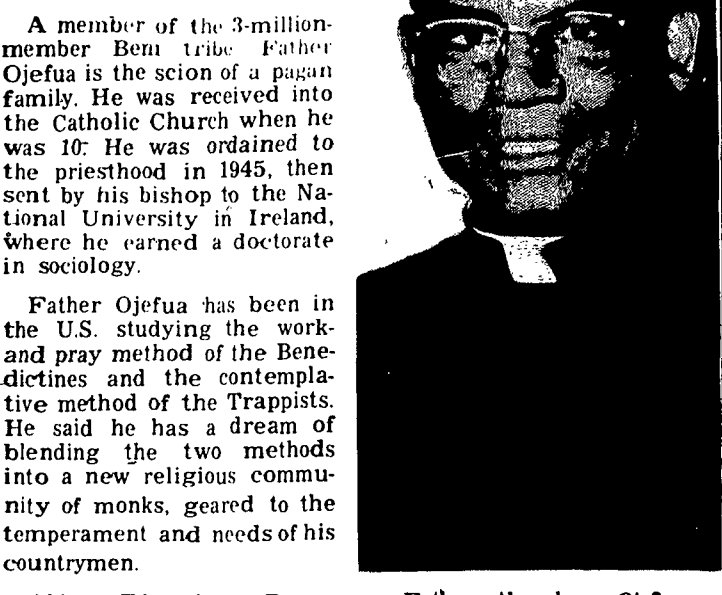
New Religious Community in Nigeria

Memphis, Tenn.—(NC)—Father Abraham Ojefua, left here for his native Nigeria with a dream of founding a new religious community to aid his 50 million countrymen.

A member of the 3-million-member Ben tribe, Father Ojefua is the scion of a pagan family. He was received into the Catholic Church when he was 10. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1945, then sent by his bishop to the National University in Ireland, where he earned a doctorate in sociology.

Father Ojefua has been in the U.S. studying the work and pray method of the Benedictines and the contemplative method of the Trappists. He said he has a dream of blending the two methods into a new religious community of monks, geared to the temperament and needs of his countrymen.

Abbot Flavian Burns, O.S.S.O., of the Trappist community, financed Father Ojefua's return trip to Nigeria and also has undertaken to raise \$5,000 to aid the Nigerian priest in building a monastery in the jungle — with cells for eight monks, a library, dining room and chapel.
