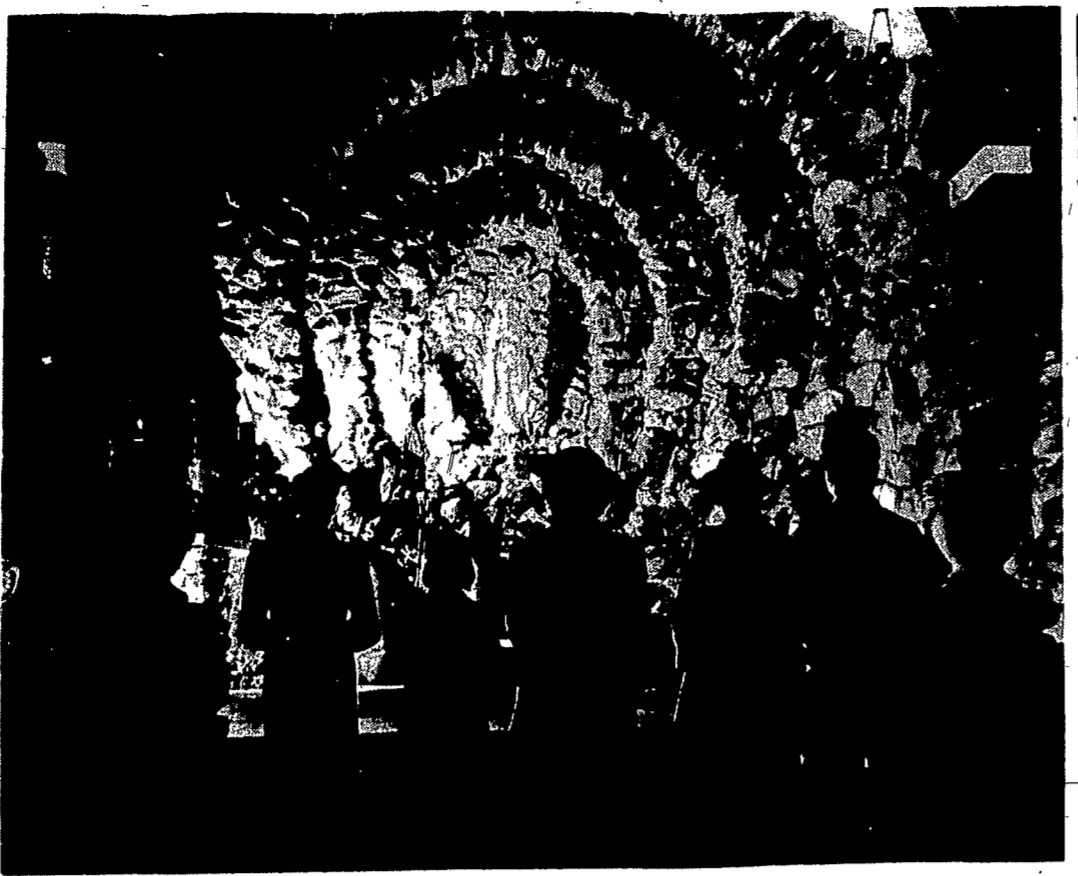

Lady of Lourdes Shrine Near Albany
 International pilgrimages to the Shrine of Our Lady of Lourdes in France have attracted millions of persons. Here in the United States, numerous shrines to Our Lady of Lourdes have been built including one only 24 miles from Albany at New Lebanon in the Lebanon Valley, 11 miles from Pittsfield, Mass. The shrine was built in 1929 and among its relics is the heart of St. Bernadette, to whom Our Lady of Lourdes made 18 appearances in the grotto of Massabielle, near Lourdes, France.

Women's Rights Get Some Notice in Africa
 There is a movement going on in the heart of Africa to get the girls out of the kitchen and into the busy 20th Century world. All over Uganda, according to a visiting native bishop, young girls are longing to go to high school, and their parents are ready to make "great sacrifices."

Bishop Adrian Ddungu of Masaka said that in his equatorial country, where more than half the natives are Christian, young men are getting all the breaks. Men even hold the jobs in offices and stores that elsewhere would be filled by girls out of high school. There are scarcely any women teachers, administrators, politicians or government workers. Concentration on the education of boys has led to such inequality that there are "very serious repercussions on family life," the bishop told the Courier-Journal.
