TV Portrait of Pope Acclaimed in England

London—(RNS)—A picture of Pope Paul as a friendly man to whom (Christianity means) love and charity is one which emerged from a striking hour-long television program, "The Sixth Paul," shown here to mark the fifth anniversary of the Pontiff's coronation.

Filmed in Rome, Vatican City and elsewhere and shown by the independent television company, Rediffusion, the documentary won widespread praise from TV critics in both religious and lay journals.

A critic in the lay Daily Telegraph described the program as one of "considerable merit," adding: "The Pope was shown as a man to whom Christianity means 'love, charity and humility, not thrones, crowns and gold.'"

"He is obviously regarded with immense affection. The enthusiasm and joy of those who welcomed him as he was seen in his journeys outside the Vatican to several countries overseas was well recorded by the camera."

The Times' critic said the film was "crisp, clear, informative and conspicuously well photographed. The picture of the Pope that emerged was a fascinating one."
