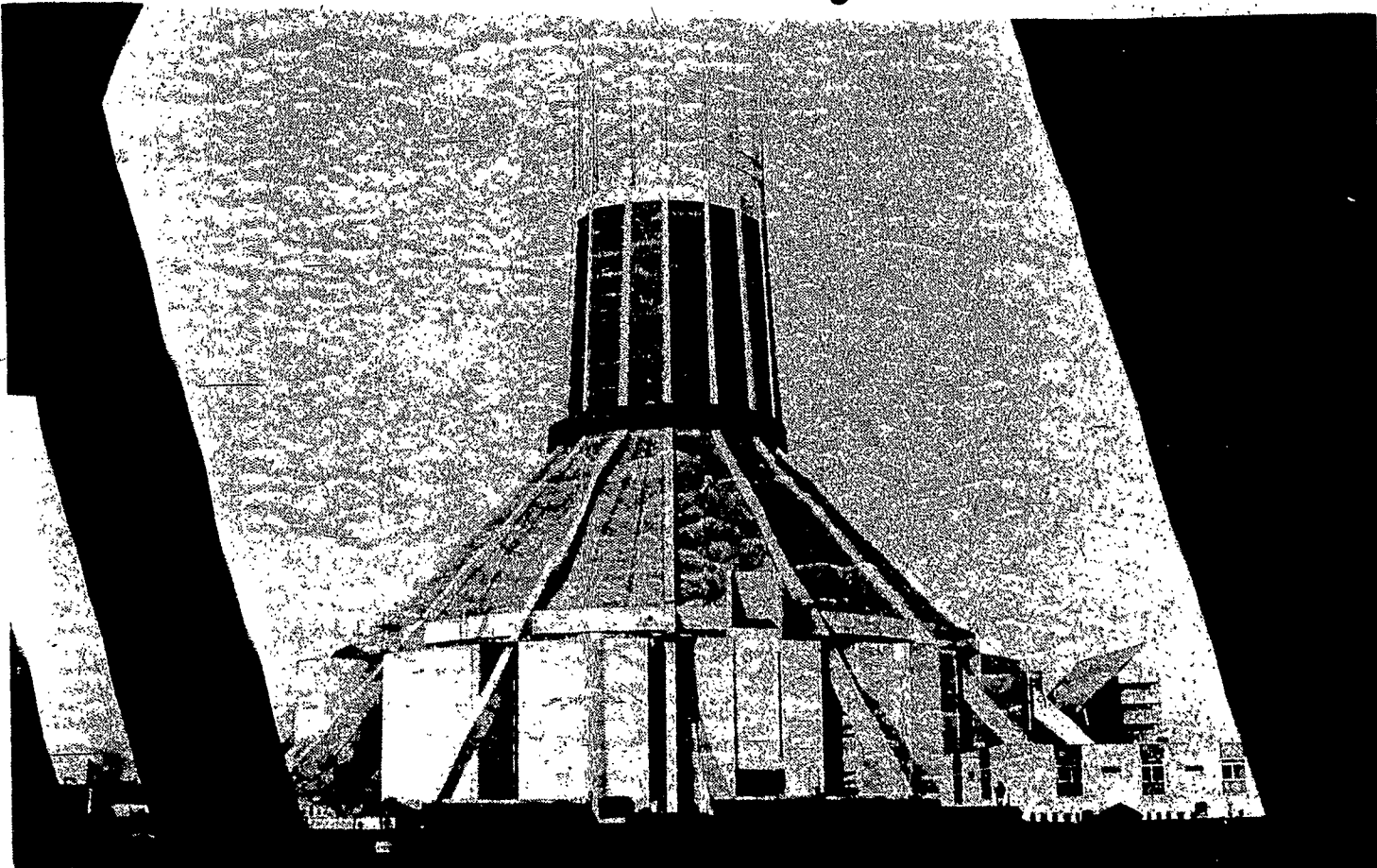


# Famous Churches of the World

## Liturgical Music Workshops Set

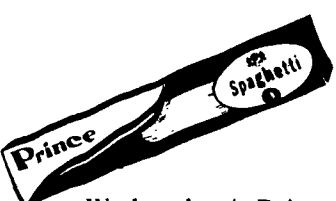

Saturday's program will stress wedding and funeral music, new hymns, and Masses in morning and afternoon reading sessions.

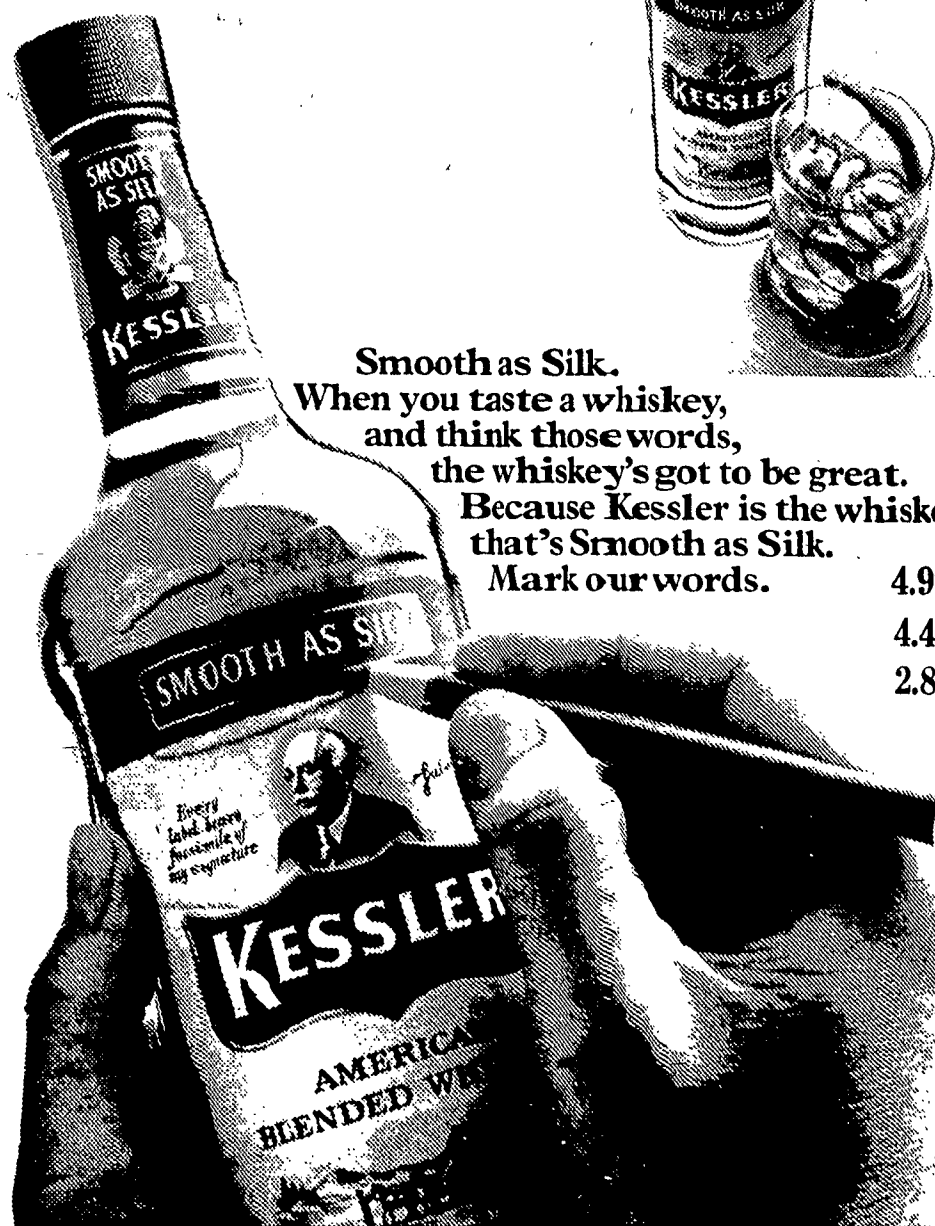

## 100 British Priests Quit in Year, Paper Says

London—The Times, Britain's senior daily newspaper, has reported (Aug. 17) that more than 100 Catholic priests in this country had resigned in the past year, surpassing any previous year.

The Times, after an investigation by its own staff, said "the startling figure reflects a growing disillusionment about the structure and authority of the Church in the past few years."

Birth control, celibacy and other issues had been the

immediate cause of most such defections, "but the unbending authority of the Church is the root cause," the Times reported.

"Our inquiries revealed that there is more at stake than the ideas of young reactionaries against authority," it added. "The angry young men of the Church of Rome have not taken their decisions lightly or spontaneously. Most believe the Roman Catholic Church to be the ideal expression of Christianity but question the attitudes which are now dominating it."

The Times said that the increase in defections could be explained by the example of one man—Charles Davis, a

highly respected theologian. When he left in 1966 and married after declaring his fundamental differences on dogmas, "he caused doubt among many young radically minded priests about their convictions."

All stressed that they were not troublemakers. The Times reported. As intelligent and sincere men they resented the stigma usually attached to them by their superiors, it said.

Most, if not all, emphasized their strong belief in the faith, the paper said, and had not thought of changing their allegiance. They had just come to the end of their tether as priests restricted

in action by tradition and authority.

One hundred is a very small proportion of the priests in England and Wales, which have about 8,000 in all—including nearly 3,000 members of Religious orders.
