Fall days are here, golden and crisp. There's something about a sunny day with a bit of a nip in the air that inspires you to bake a cake. Besides, what better way could there be to procrastinate another day in fall house-cleaning the bedroom closet!

We've never known a family that wouldn't rather have homemade cake than clean closets. And making a cake "from scratch" is a good deal more soul-satisfying for you than closet cleaning any day, especially when the cake is a very special one, like Grape Cake. It's a classic "creaming method" cake that's featherylight and tender.

A perfect complement to the cake's delicate texture is its unusual filling and frosting, which give your velvety cake a taste as rich as a fall fruit stand. Based on bottled grape juice, a package of pudding and pie filling, and flaked coconut, the filling can be quickly cooked up while the cake merrily rises in the oven; then the filling chills while the cake is cooling. The pastel frosting is a cooked one of the "four minute" type, and echoes the grape flavor of the filling.

GRAPE CAKE

1% cups sifted cake flour

2¼ teaspoons double - acting baking powder ½ teaspoon salt 1/2 cup shortening 1 cup plus 2 tablespoons

sugar 2 eggs ¾ cup milk 1 teaspoon vanilla

Grape and Coconut Fill-Fluffy Grape Frosting

Sift flour with baking powder and salt. Cream shortening. Gradually add sugar; cream until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating thoroughly after each addition. -Add flour mixture alternately with milk, a small amount at a time, beating after each addition until smooth. Stir in vanilla. Pour into two 8-inch layer pans which have been lined on bottoms with paper. Bake at 375° for 25 to 30 minutes, or until cake tester inserted into centers comes out clean. Cool cake in pans 10 minutes; then remove from pans and finish

cooling on racks. Split each layer in half, making 4 layers. Spread Grape and Coconut Filling between layers, using about 3% cup flaked coconut, if desired.

GRAPE AND COCONUT FILLING

34 cup water 2 teaspoons lemon juice 1 tablespoon butter % cup flaked coconlt

Place pudding mix in a saucepan. Gradually stir in grape juice, water, and lemon juice. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly until mixture comes to a full boil. Remove from heat; stir in butter and coconut. Chill. Stir before spreading. Makes about 2 cups.

FLUFFY GRAPE FROSTING

1 egg white 34 cup sugar Dash of salt 2 tablespoons grape juice

1 tablespoon water 1 teaspoon lemon juice Combine ingredients in top of small double boiler or in small bowl. Beat with electric mixer or rotary beater

until thoroughly mixed about 1 minute. Place over boiling water and beat constantly at high speed of electric mixer (or with rotary beater) until frosting stands in stiff peaks — about 4 minutes, stirring frosting up from bottom and sides of pan occasionally with rubber scraper, spatula, or spoon.

Remove from boiling water. For a very smooth and satiny frosting, pour at once into a

large bowl for final beating
