The scholarship program is conducted annually and is open to any Catholic graduate of a recognized high school in New York State during the term ending January or June 1969.

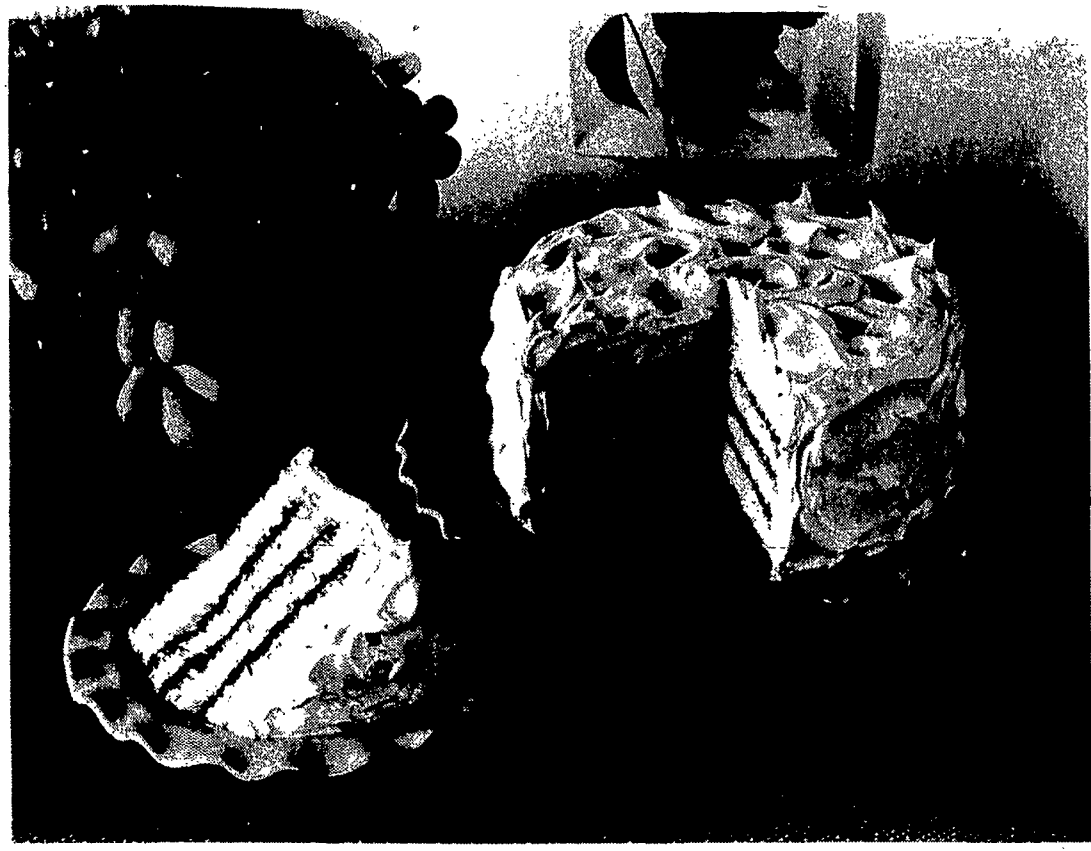

A Vintage Touch of Grape

Fall days are here, golden and crisp. There's something about a sunny day with a bit of a nip in the air that inspires you to bake a cake. Besides, what better way could there be to procrastinate another day in fall house-clearing the bedroom closet!

We've never known a family that wouldn't rather have homemade cake than clean closets. And making a cake "from scratch" is a good deal more soul-satisfying for you than closet cleaning any day, especially when the cake is a very special one, like Grape Cake. It's a classic "creaming method" cake that's feathery-light and tender.

A perfect complement to the cake's delicate texture is its unusual filling and frosting, which give your velvety cake a taste as rich as a fall fruit stand. Based on bottled grape juice, a package of pudding and pie filling, and flaked coconut, the filling can be quickly cooked up while the cake merrily rises in the oven; then the filling chills while the cake is cooling. The pastel frosting is a cooked one of the "four minute" type, and echoes the grape flavor of the filling.

- 2 1/4 teaspoons double-acting baking powder
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 1/2 cup shortening
 - 1 cup plus 2 tablespoons sugar
 - 2 eggs
 - 3/4 cup milk
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla
 - Grape and Coconut Filling
 - Fluffy Grape Frosting
- Sift flour with baking powder and salt. Cream shortening. Gradually add sugar; cream until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating thoroughly after each addition. Add flour mixture alternately with milk, a small amount at a time, beating after each addition until smooth. Stir in vanilla. Pour into two 8-inch layer pans which have been lined on bottoms with paper. Bake at 375° for 25 to 30 minutes, or until cake tester inserted into centers comes out clean. Cool cake in pans 10 minutes; then remove from pans and finish cooling on racks.
- Split each layer in half, making 4 layers. Spread Grape and Coconut Filling between layers, using about 3/4 cup flaked coconut, if desired.

GRAPE CAKE
1 1/2 cups sifted cake flour

GRAPE AND COCONUT FILLING
1 package (3 1/2 oz.) vanilla pudding and pie filling
1 cup grape juice

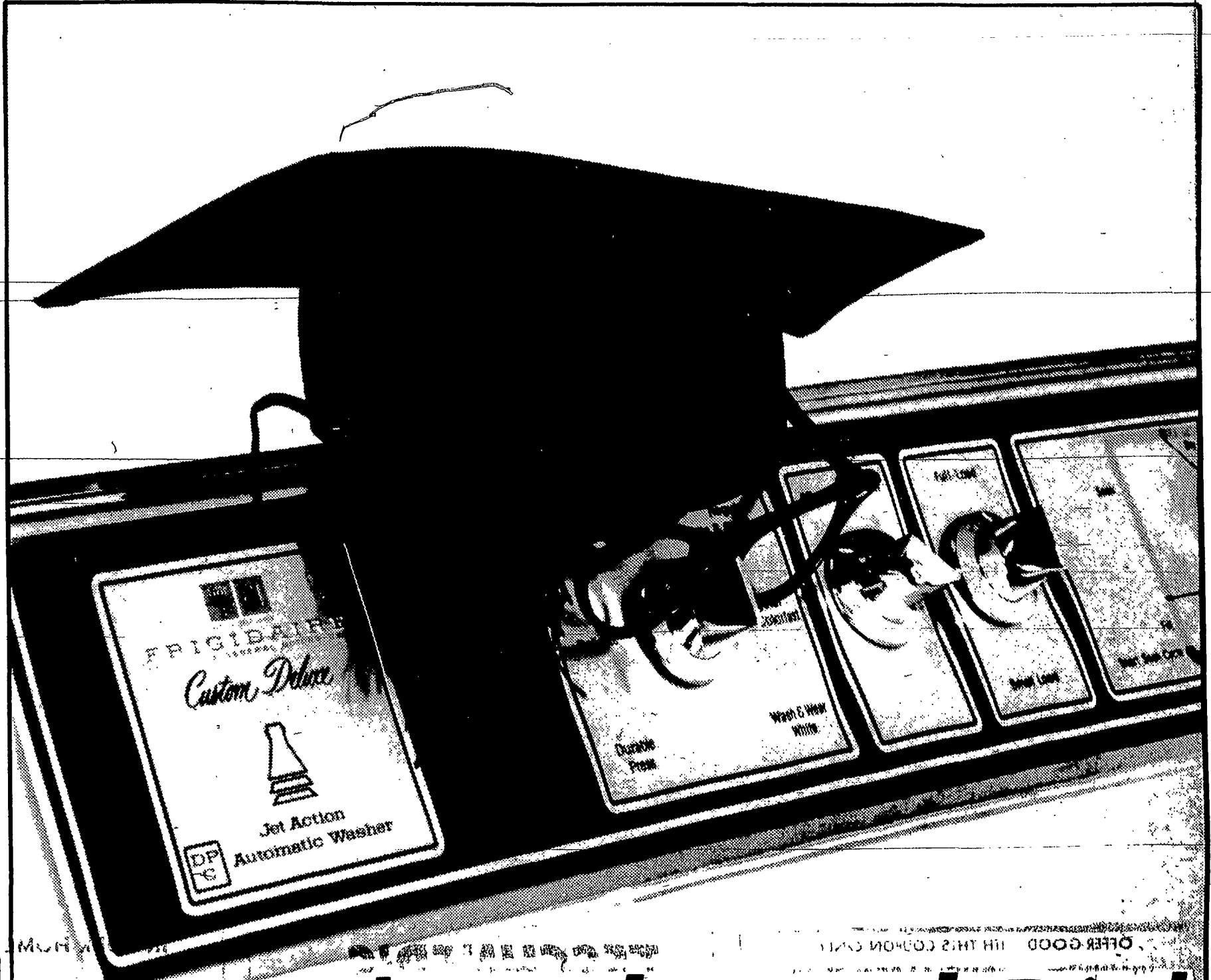
