The Rochester Polish People's Home, established 50 years ago to keep an immigrant community together, will have two anniversary celebrations this weekend.

The dinner speaker will be Dr. Eugene Kusielewicz, Brooklyn-born Polish historian. Dr. Kusielewicz, a prolific writer on middle European affairs, is an editor of Polish American Studies and a founder of the Polish American World. He is a member of the advisory board of the Josef Pilsudski Institute for Research in the Modern History of Poland, and has made eight trips to his ancestral homeland as a student of its history and culture. He served several years on the staff of St. John's University.

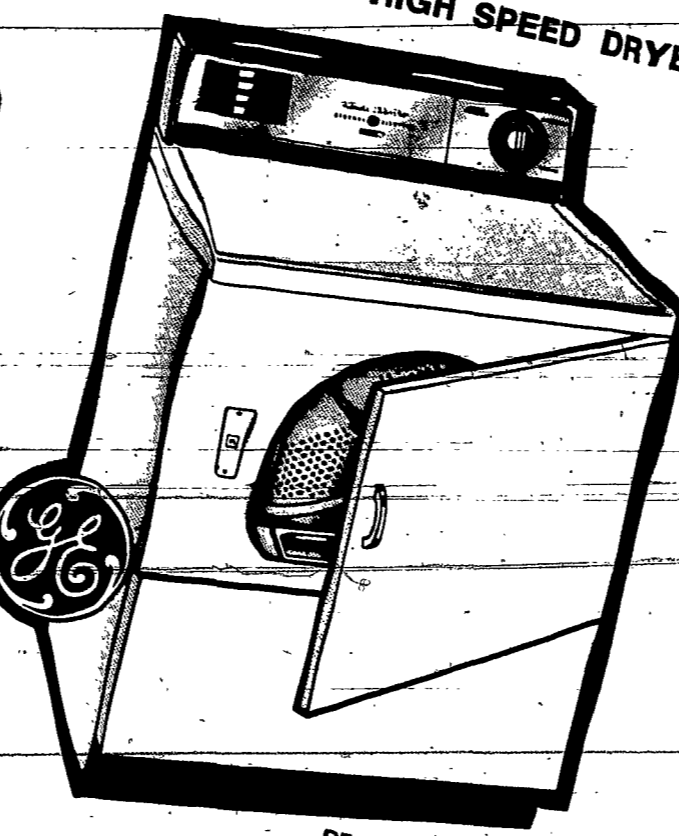
