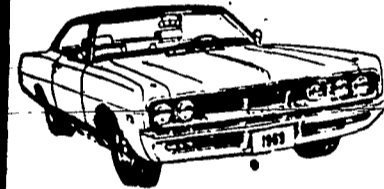

Christian Family Movement Boasts 200,000 Members

The Christian Family Movement, as the name implies, is a Christian lay movement by, for, and of married couples. An international movement headquartered in Chicago, it now consists of around 100,000 couples. In the Rochester diocese, there are about 150 couples active in the movement, with approximately 18 priests serving as chaplains.

The movement is designed to form more mature Christians through the development of couples, their families, and others in their personal relationships. This development takes place through an aroused social consciousness and involvement. Originally almost a totally Catholic effort, it has shifted gears in the last two years and now is a truly Christian movement with programs designed for use by Christians of all denominations, particularly ecumenical groups.

CFM's in groups of five to eight couples meet in each other's homes every two weeks. Each group normally has a chaplain as a spiritual guide. The chaplains are usually priests, but may be ministers (in ecumenical groups),

nuns, or seminarians. Using a programmed guide, a CFM group follows a logically developing theme, which can range from the effects of change on family life to world poverty, during a program year. The programs are completely new each year and are based on those topics or problems deemed to be most relevant. For instance, this year's current book "SHALOM", concerns itself with the world's primary concern: peace; — peace in the city, peace in the world, and peace in the family.

Meetings Have Structure

Meetings last about two hours and usually consist of two basic sections, a reflections segment and a social inquiry section. During the reflection part of the meeting readings selected from both the Bible and current thought-provoking readings are designed to stimulate discussion and enable couples to share their reactions.

Using thoughts generated during the first part of the meeting, the "Social Inquiry" section then provides a framework for decision and action by the group. This is the heart of the meeting and utilizes the Observe, Judge, and Act technique.

In this section of the meeting, each

couple reports on observations made during the previous two weeks regarding some area of common interest. After discussing the reported observations, the group then makes a judgement on the situation. This is followed by an agreed-upon specific action to be undertaken by the group. This mutually agreed-upon action by married couples preceded by thoughtful reflection and discussion is the essence and culmination of the meeting.

The group actions are not necessarily "big" ones, but should be geared

to individual member's abilities, talents and desires. At Pat and Patty Crowley, national secretary-couple point out unceasingly, "The idea is to allow the members to form themselves." The meetings usually conclude with remarks by the chaplain followed by coffee and refreshments.

Acting For Christ

In CFM the emphasis is placed on loving Christ through love and concern for our fellow man. This is ac-

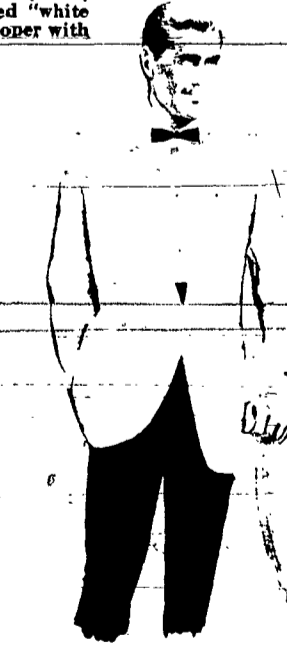
