

Elmira Sister Wins Scholarship Grant

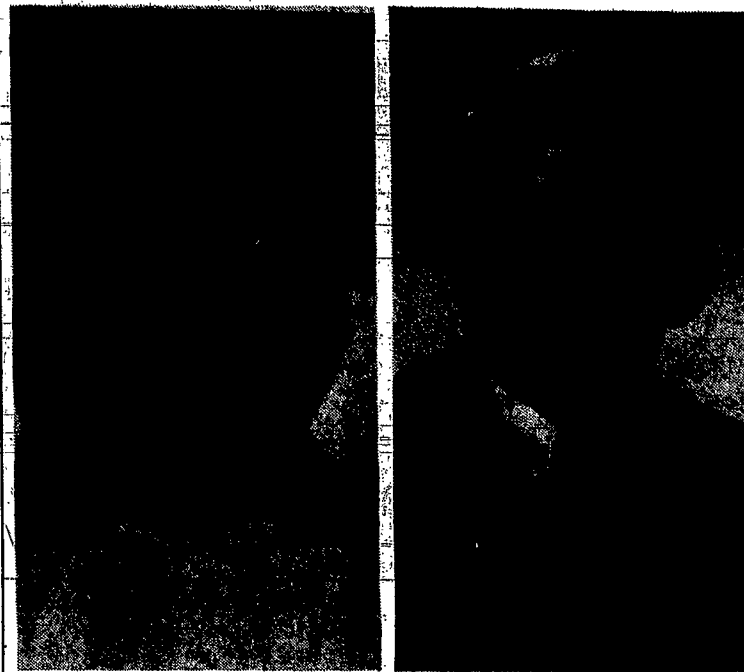
Elmira — Sister Eileen Popkock, a native of Albany and a teacher at Notre Dame High School here, has been awarded a grant in the Experienced Teacher's Fellowship Program.

The program includes a year of academic study at the University of Arkansas, followed by nine weeks of study in France. Tuition and fees are waived and a stipend of approximately \$5,000 is offered.

Applications for the grant were accepted from all of the 50 states, preference being given to applicants from the southern states.

Sister Eileen has studied at the University of Rochester and the University of Fairfield in Connecticut. She received her associate degree from Catherine McAuley College and her B.A. from the College of St. Rose in Albany.

Sister teaches French and English at Notre Dame and is advisor for the yearbook. She is drama club adviser, a Junior homeroom moderator and a member of the faculty review board. Last summer Sister Eileen was involved in the Elmira Ecumenical Service Project.

St. Joseph Sisters Set Summer Program

A summer "enrichment program" for elementary schoolers will be conducted in July by the Sisters of St. Joseph in three Monroe County locations.

The program includes morning classes Monday through Friday, from July 7 to Aug. 1, at St. Ambrose School, Nazareth Hall Cadet School and St. Lawrence School.

Courses will range from art and African History through creative expression, film study, science, and individualized reading. Fee for each course is \$25, and a pupil is limited to a maximum of two courses.

Classes are open to any pupils in grades three through eight who are recommended by their teachers for this advanced work. Information may be obtained through any of the centers.

Among instructors will be Sisters whose regular assignments are as teachers at Nazareth College, St. Agnes High School and Nazareth Academy, and others in specialized work of the community.
