135 Attend Meeting On Nursing Care At St. James Hospital

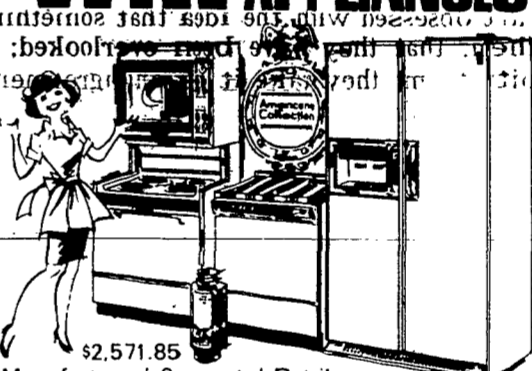

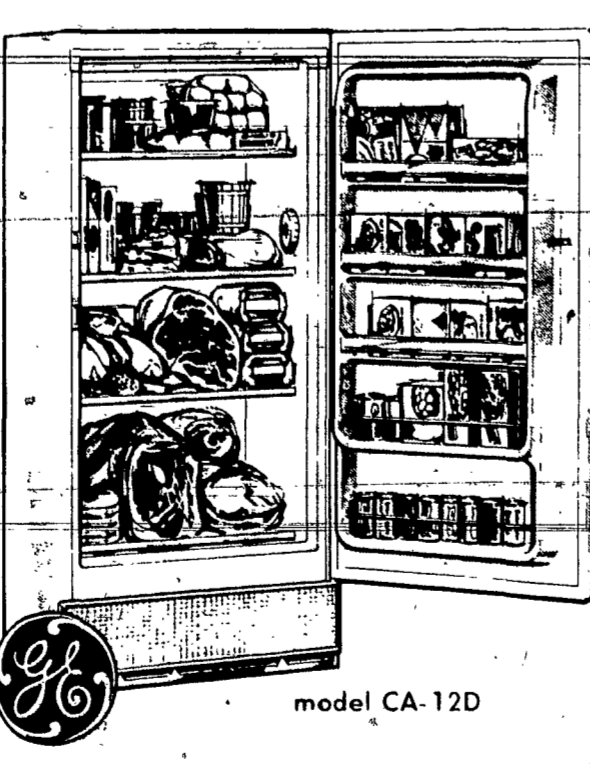
