Washington — (NC) — A position paper containing strong endorsement of "academic freedom" at Catholic colleges and universities has been submitted to the Congregation for Catholic Education in Rome by an international group of Catholic educators.

Five Seminars Scheduled on Liturgy Music

Church musicians and others interested in music for the modern Church will be gathering from all parts of the country to attend five separate liturgical music seminars sponsored by the Gregorian Institute of America during July and August. Priests, nuns, choir directors, organists, instrumentalists will strengthen their sense of direction and security in their task of leading today's Church in the worship of God through music.

In the Houston area the musicians will meet at Dominican College July 28, 29 and 30.

College Misericordia at Dallas, Pa., will be the site of a seminar Aug. 4, 5 and 6. The Newark, N.J., archdiocese was selected for a workshop at Caldwell College, Caldwell, August 7, 8 and 9.

The New England Conservatory in Boston will be the scene of a fourth seminar Aug. 11, 12 and 13. Belleville, Ill., in the greater St. Louis area, will be the gathering spot for a liturgical music meet Aug. 18, 19 and 20.

The institute has reached out to all parts of the country to obtain the most distinguished musicians for its seminar faculty. Organ technique, hymnody, psalmody, diction, choral work, folk music, all facets of church music will be taught.

New Forms Mailed For Medicaid

The Monroe County Department of Social Services has mailed out new Medicaid eligibility certification forms to 10,712 families in Monroe County who are receiving medical assistance but who are not receiving basic welfare assistance.

Mrs. Catherine M. Manning, deputy director of social services, emphasized that the forms must be filled out, signed and returned to the department by June 30 or Medicaid coverage will expire.

The forms are part of an eligibility review made necessary by recent State legislative cutbacks in Medicaid.

OFM Provincial Killed in Crash

Flora, Ill. — (NC) — Father Germain Schwab, OFM, provincial of the 15-state Midwestern province of the Franciscan Fathers, was killed in a head-on auto crash May 31 on a rain-swept highway near here.

Father Schwab, 53, a former professor at the Franciscan's Teutopolis, Ill., seminary, was elected provincial in 1966. He was to have presided at the province's general renewal chapter, beginning June 9, at Quincy (Ill.) College.

UNESCO OBSERVER

Vatican City — (NC) — Pope Paul VI has named Msgr. Edouardo Rovida permanent observer of the Holy See to the United Nations' Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO).

SPANISH BISHOP

Vatican City — (NC) — Pope Paul VI has named Father Ricardo Carles Gordo bishop of Tortosa, Spain (June 9).

The document was released here in behalf of the U.S. delegation to the meeting by Father Clarence W. Friedman, executive secretary of the college and university department, National Catholic Educational Association.

Father Friedman also sent the statement to American bishops and presidents of U.S. Catholic colleges and universities, who were asked to comment on it.

The statement was drawn up by a commission appointed by a conference on Catholic high-

er education, which met in Rome under Congregation auspices, April 25-May 2. The position paper was said to have been approved by all 31 delegates.

"To perform its teaching and research functions effectively, the Catholic university must have a true autonomy and academic freedom," the statement declares. "It is limited by no other factor than the truth it pursues. Every limitation imposed on the university which would clash with this unconditional attitude for pursuing truth would be intolerable and contrary to the very nature of the university."

Other points in the statement: "The Church has the right and the responsibility to determine Catholic belief and to define Catholic moral principles. To this authority, all Catholics are subject, whether lay or cleric, preacher or theological scholar.

"The theological scholar, in taking his place in the university, must be able to pursue his discipline in the same manner as other research scholars."

"His work should normally be reviewed and evaluated by his scholarly peers, as is the case in other disciplines."

"As an individual he is bound to accept the authentic teaching of the Church and to submit to its legitimately exercised authority. As a theological scholar he is bound, by the nature of his discipline, to take into proper account the pronouncements of the Church.

"In a university without relationships with ecclesiastical or religious superiors, these authorities may deal with the theologian as an individual member of the Church.

"In other institutions provision is made for appropriate action by designated ecclesiastical or religious superiors. In

all cases, however, any action taken by ecclesiastical or religious superiors should conform exactly to their authority as established in the university statutes and should be carried out according to those procedures of due process established in the statutes and recognized as general university common law in the geographical region of the particular university."

The document says that although members of a Catholic university "constitute a special sort of community," they "are subject to episcopal authority in the same way as any parish."

"The university community

is especially appropriate for authorized experimentation, particularly concerning ways to make Christianity more relevant to their lives."

The document states: "Since a university usually transcends the limits, the needs, and the conditions of a single diocese, it might be well to establish a bishop or a group of bishops for the university ministries—as is often done for the military chaplaincy."

In addition to Fathers Heshburgh and Friedman, other delegates representing America's 40 Catholic universities at the Rome meeting were Father Robert J. Henle, S.J., academic

vice president of St. Louis University, and president-designate of Georgetown University; Father Neil G. McCluskey, S.J., dean-director of the Institute for Studies in Education at Notre Dame; Msgr. John J. McGrath, president of Saint Mary's College, Notre Dame, Ind.; Father Michael J. Walsh, S.J., president of Fordham University; and Brother Gregory Nugent, F.S.C., president of Manhattan College, New York, N.Y. Daniel L. Schlafly, chairman of the St. Louis University board of trustees, was an alternate delegate. Other delegates came from Europe, Africa, Latin America, the Far East and Asia.
