Father Victor Valentovic, OFM, Cap., administrator of St. Pius X Church in Van Etten, will mark the 25th anniversary of his ordination Sunday, June 22, at a Mass in his home parish in New York City.

Father Valentovic, who lives at St. Fidelis Friary, Interlaken, has been pastor for eight years to the people of the Van Etten, Spencer and Erin areas. St. Pius Church was completed under his direction. He has served parishes in Wisconsin and New York City. In 1954 he was appointed as first resident chaplain at Children's Village, Dobbs Ferry. His anniversary Mass will be at 3 p.m. at Our Lady Queen of Angels, East 113th Street.

Nazareth Offers Art Workshops

Nazareth College will offer summer workshops in jewelry, ceramics and sculpture, which may be taken with or without credit.

The jewelry course, which runs from June 30 through July 18, covers all fundamentals of jewelry making and design. The sculpture course begins July 21 and runs through August 8, with an exploration of the principles, media and techniques in the design of contemporary sculpture.

Ceramics is being taught in two sections. Section 1 runs from June 30 through July 18, and section 2 will be given from July 21 through August 8. Curriculum will include instruction for the beginner and the experienced ceramics student in nearly all phases of hand and wheel thrown construction.

Registration for the workshops will be at Nazareth June 27 and 28.

Frank C. Argento of Gates has been elected president of the 2,400-member St. John Fisher Alumni Association.

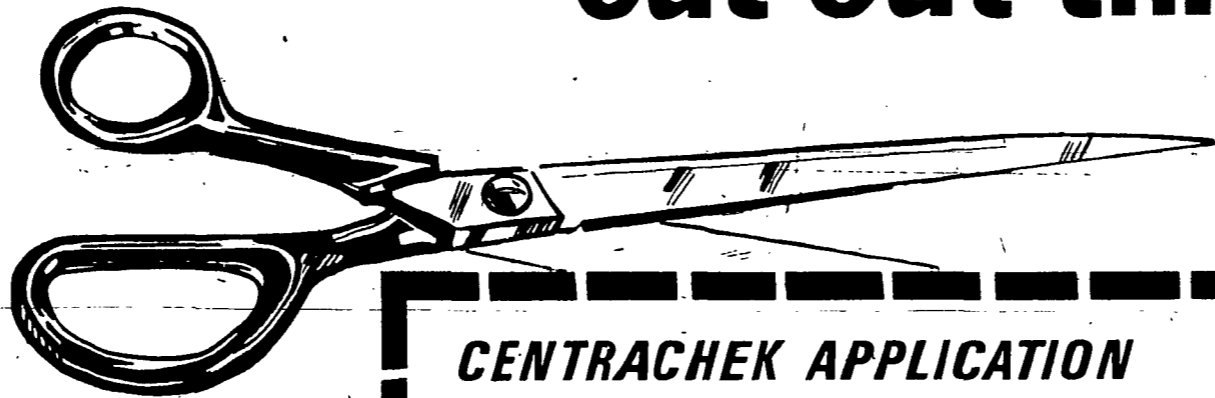
Frank R. Webster of Brighton is the new vice president. David B. Ehmman of Fairport is secretary and Colin P. Monteith, Rochester, is treasurer.

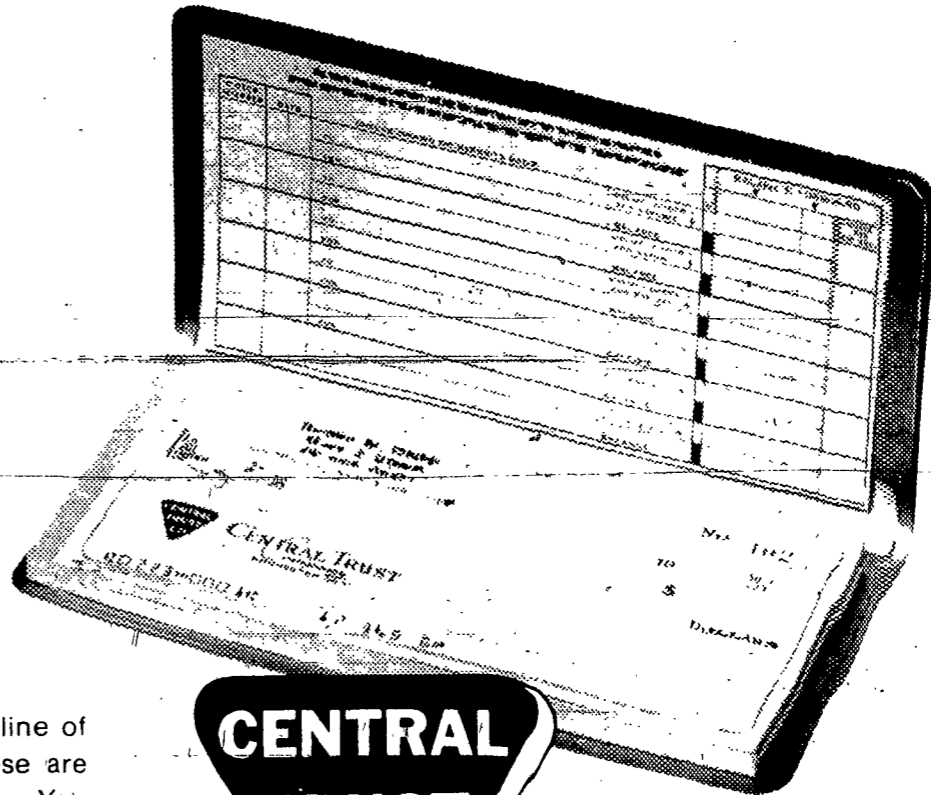
