Sex l To S

Improved rather than deterred by the publicity of last spring's diocesan sex education program will continue to be the curriculum in diocesan elementary and high schools.

The Diocesan School Board in an official statement last week said: "Bishop [John J. Neenan] is reviewing the evaluation program, made at the request of the Committee on Sex Education and Professions, and their findings on the program, and approved for the curriculum."

The program was approved as a pilot course in diocesan elementary schools in the summer of 1968 and after review that Summer was approved for the diocese during the year.

A survey conducted among 3,113 parish children had shown that 90 percent of the program all year showed a 100 percent approval of the course material for the children.

By vast majority the children agreed that "the program was good."

OCF Center To Open In Auburn

Auburn — Formation of a Christian Doctrine Center is scheduled for Tuesday, Sept. 3.

Father Raymond Glogowski, parochial vicar for the Sacred Heart Church, and Father Glogowski, Christian Doctrine coordinator for Cayuga County, announced that the center will be opened in the Sacred Heart Church.

The center will have an office and an audio-visual room.

Father Glogowski will conduct regular meetings for Christian Doctrine for grades one through six that day in St. Joseph School.
