Make the Most of Talent

Johnny and Susie are no longer being "taught religion" by "Sister".

Although most parishes in the Diocese are very far away from the 1972 Diocesan goal of a full-time professional religious education coordinator in each parish, there are many CCD groups that have established efficient and well organized operations.

These well managed programs are the result of careful planning and efficient operating procedures that best utilize the efforts of the many volunteers who are the mainstay of the Diocese of Rochester CCD organization.

At a panel discussion at one of the teacher-training sessions last season several CCD administrators shared their ideas, methods, and experiences with the class. Some of their suggestions may prove helpful to those of you involved in launching a new school year.

The panel was composed of Dr. Robert Lyons of St. Helen's parish, Mr. Arthur Maurer of St. James Parish, Sr. Mary Jo of St. Helen's, and Sr. Gilmary who was then with the CCD Office.

One theme emphasized again and again was the need for organization. Organization is absolutely essential for efficient utilization of time, personnel, and resources. But before organization can begin it is necessary to define your goals. Realizing that becoming Christianized requires establishing a relationship with God through His son Jesus Christ and realizing that this relationship is a very personal "happening", nevertheless as with all personal encounters the persons involved must be introduced to one another and the conditions of their meeting must be such that it can develop into friendship.

Here then is the reason for organization—to insure that the time, people, and effort involved are geared to creating the best possible atmosphere and conditions for this relationship to grow.

Keeping in mind this basic, overall goal, work out your program to involve priests and parents as well as CCD personnel. Since the parents are the most important single influence in the child's life it is essential to involve them and aid them in what is uti-

mately their responsibility—the religious formation of their children.

Recruitment of personnel is a major task. In order for teachers to function efficiently a well organized back up force is necessary. At least one general administrator is necessary. His duties will depend on whether or not there is an overall parish religious education director.

An office staff is also necessary to handle registration records, correspondence, ma-

terials procurement, copying or duplicating materials for teachers. Helpers can also be in charge of A-V materials, special art or music classes or used as classroom helpers. Draw on the talent present in every parish for specific aspects of your program.

A teenager with a guitar may say more to a class in a short sing along than a half hour lecture from the teacher.

Relieve teachers of as much of the mechanics of the classroom situation as possible so they can devote the main part of their time and efforts to preparing and teaching their classes. Team teaching or using an assistant teacher (possibly someone taking the teachers' training course) can relieve a teacher of some of the paperwork and other time consuming non-teaching activities that must be done.
