

Elmira Interfaith Chapel Dedicated

Elmira—A new interfaith chapel at St. Joseph's Hospital was formally dedicated on Dec. 12. Auxiliary Bishop John E. McCafferty presided. Following greetings by Charles Kennedy, chairman of the board of directors of the hospital, the Rev. Stephen R. Parr, president of the Chemung County Ministerial Association, greeted the congregation.

Readings from the Scriptures were given by Werner Bloch, M.D., member of the hospital Medical Staff. Father Cyril Guise, O.C.D., chaplain of the hospital; the Rev. Samuel W. Hale, Jr., of Grace Episcopal Church. The family and closing prayer were offered by Father Benjamin Greene, O.C.D., of the Carmelite Monastery.

The new chapel is located between the hospital and the Nurses' Residence. There are no doors; three openings extend a warm welcome to patients, relatives and friends, hospital personnel and others to come inside and worship. Soft lighting and carpeting emphasizing the colors of the stained glass windows create a

prayerful atmosphere. There are wooden screens, made in Albuquerque, New Mexico, that are used to cover the windows when a Jewish service is being held. Clergy of any faith have been invited to schedule services. Arrangements may be made by contacting the hospital chaplain.

The altar is five-foot square and is flanked on three sides by pews. On the fourth side, nearest the windows, are two pedestals beneath spotlights. On one the Bible is enthroned; on the other rests the Blessed Sacrament. The organ used in the chapel was donated by the board of directors at the time of the hospital's golden jubilee. The Stations of the Cross are located in the carpeted hallway rather than inside the chapel.

The renovated area includes a new board room and chaplains' suite. This renovation freed five rooms in the hospital for use as offices.

Among the many persons to be thanked for contributing toward mak-
