

Campus Ministry Meet Set

Annual meeting and election of the diocesan Campus Ministry Apostolate is scheduled from 8:30 to 8 p.m. Saturday, March 14, in the Newman Oratory, 101 Kenyon St., Brockport.

Reports will be presented by Father Michael E. Daly, diocesan director; Father Thomas R. Statt for the Rochester area and Father David W. Connor for the Southern Tier.

Discussing the role of women in campus ministry will be Sister Ann Norwood, RC. The role of faculty advisers will be out-

lined by Dr. Robert Thompson of the State University College at Brockport.

Student leaders from the University of Rochester, Rochester Institute of Technology and State University College at Geneseo and Brockport will conduct panels on approaches to student participation in the campus ministry.

Seventeen priests are chap-

lains at the 17 universities and colleges in twelve communities of the diocese. Four Sisters are serving as associate chaplains.
