St. Anne's to Note 40th Anniversary

Bishop Hogan will be principal celebrant of a Mass of Thanksgiving at 5 p.m. Monday, April 27, in St. Anne's Church, 1600 Mt. Hope Ave., to mark the 40th anniversary of the Brighton parish.

Concelebrants will be the two priests who headed the parish during its four decades—Msgr. William J. Naughton, present pastor, and Msgr. George J. Schmitt, pastor emeritus of Holy Family Church who founded and was first pastor of St. Anne's.

Msgr. Schmitt served as pastor until he was assigned to Holy Family on June 28, 1950, when he was succeeded by Msgr. McNaughton.

Msgr. Naughton announced that the parish mortgage will be burned during the Mass.

St. Anne's first church was dedicated by Bishop John F. O'Hern on Feb. 9, 1930. On March 27, 1944, the building was almost totally destroyed by fire, and for several years devotions were held in the parish hall, erected in 1934. The present church was opened in February, 1959.

St. Anne's School was opened in 1949. It is staffed by four Sisters of St. Joseph and five lay teachers, and currently has an enrollment of 300 pupils. Sister Clare de Paul is principal.

The parish purchased a house at 327 Warrington Dr. for a convent, opened in 1951. The present rectory was constructed in 1953.

His first concelebrated Mass will be offered here, at St. Andrew's, at 9:45 Sunday morning, May 17.

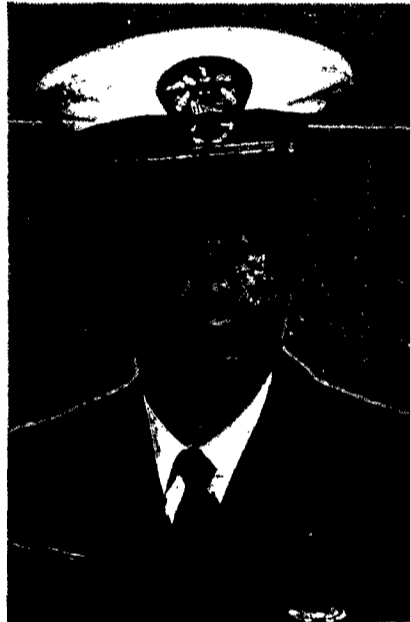
