East Rochester Principal To Join Fisher Faculty

Frank J. O'Donnell, principal of East Rochester High School for the last 22 years, will resign June 30 to join the faculty at St. John Fisher College.

He will assume duties as assistant professor of education in September. There are more than 100 students in the teacher-training department, which O'Donnell will supervise in addition to teaching.

Dr. O'Donnell attended East Rochester elementary schools and Aquinas Institute. He re-

ceived his bachelor's degree from St. Bonaventure University, his master's from the University of Rochester and doctorate from Pennsylvania State University. He taught English for 12 years in East Rochester schools before becoming principal of the high school.

O'Donnell also coached the varsity basketball team to five Monroe County championships and three Section V titles, and the baseball squad to a county championship and two Eastern County divisional titles.

He once was selected by the National Association of Secondary Principals to participate in a foreign study mission, and observed school systems in Russia, Denmark, Romania, Hungary, Yugoslavia and England.

Drug Addiction St. John Fisher Lecture Topic

A former disciple of Dr. Timothy Leary will tell of his addiction to drugs and "the road back" in a public lecture at 8 p.m., Tuesday, May 5, in Kearney Auditorium, St. John Fisher College.

Robert Moorman's topic will be, "Marijuana—Fact or Fantasy."

In 1961 Moorman began his college studies, started using drugs, and stayed on them for six years. Arrested in Tampa for grand larceny and possession of narcotics, he was confined for 14 months in the Florida State and County Prison System. For the past two years, he has lectured at schools, colleges and universities from coast-to-coast.

Ukrainian Chorus To Perform Here

The Ukrainian Bandurist Chorus of Detroit will perform at 4 p.m. Sunday, May 10, in Eastridge High School, under the auspices of the Rochester Ukrainian male chorus, "Surma."

The singers accompany themselves on the bandura, a 16th century lute-like instrument considered the national musical instrument of the Ukraine. Members of the Detroit chorus were brought to this country in 1949 from European camps for displaced persons.

Bacteriologist Joins Staff at St. Joseph's

Elmira — Arie Stuczynski, a bacteriologist, has joined the staff at St. Joseph's Hospital.

A native of Poland, he headed the bacteriology division of the department of pathology at Hillcrest Medical Center, a 600-bed hospital in Tulsa, Okla., for 10 years. He also was associated with Community General Hospital, Syracuse.

Stuczynski was a member of a research team at the University of Jerusalem which discovered and isolated a new species of leptospira which infects the liver and kidneys. The disease it causes is transmitted from cattle to human beings. A serum was developed to cure the cattle, and used on human beings it arrested the infection.

Stuczynski majored in microbiology, with minors in biochemistry and parasitology.

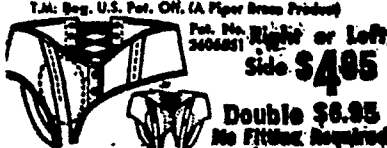
