Along with the tuition increase, Dr. Lawrence R. Schoenhals, president of the college, pointed out expansions in program made this year to upgrade curriculum and facilities. New majors have been added in sociology and social work and in physics. The art and music departments have been combined to form a new Division of Fine Arts.

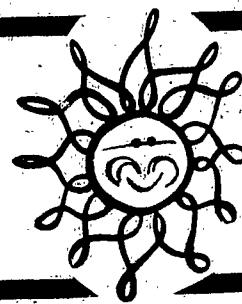
CAR WASH
